







## Monday 25 March 2024 Students and staff will have the





### Tuesday 2nd April to Monday 8th April 2024 is World Autism Acceptance Week.

At Stormont we, celebrated World Autism Acceptance Week this week by arranging a variety of activities for students to understand more about Autism and how


