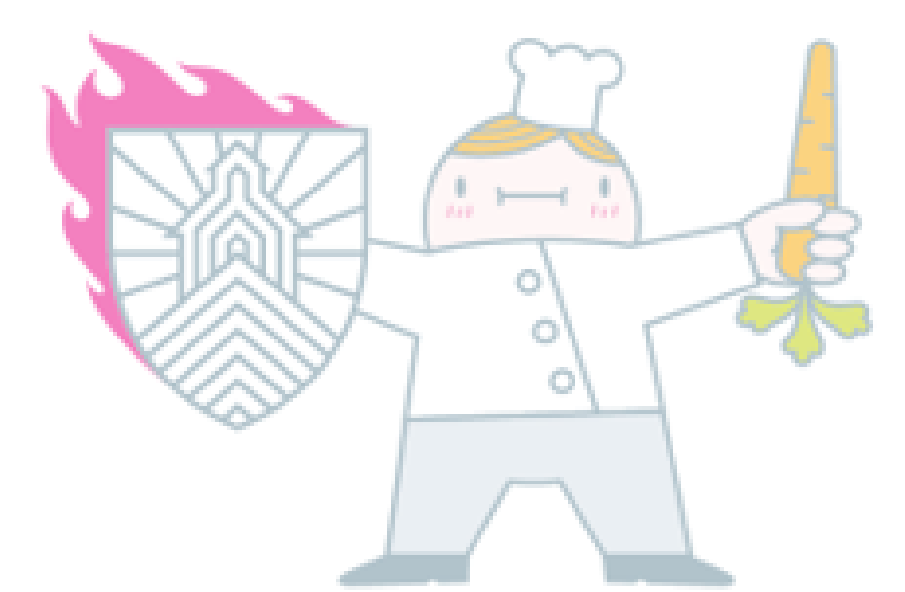

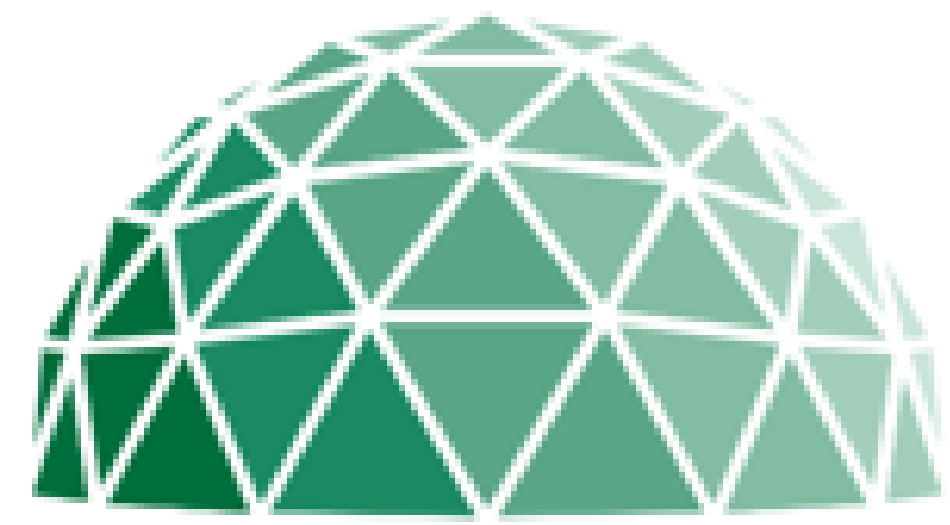

Did You Know?

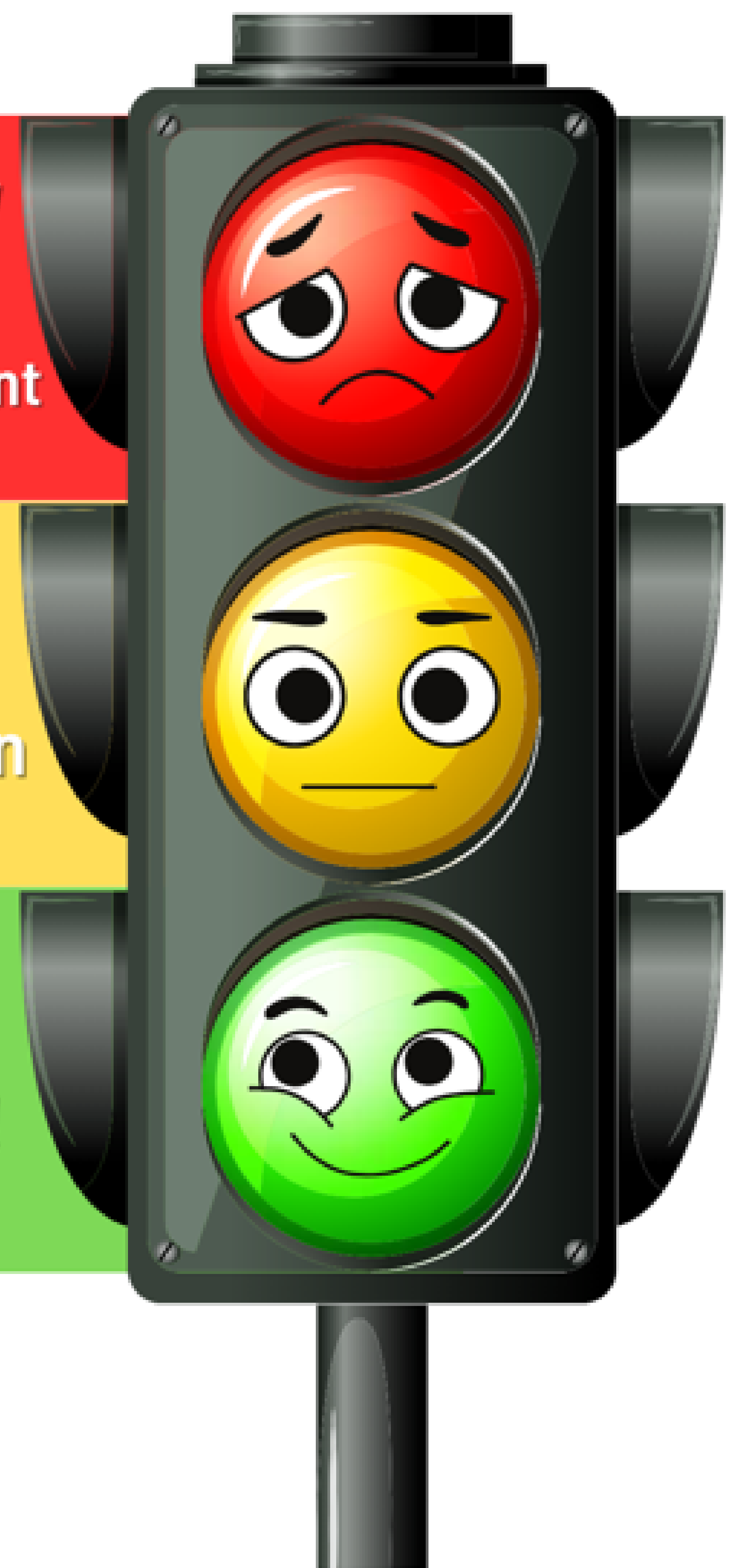
Children are required by law to attend 190 school days per year.

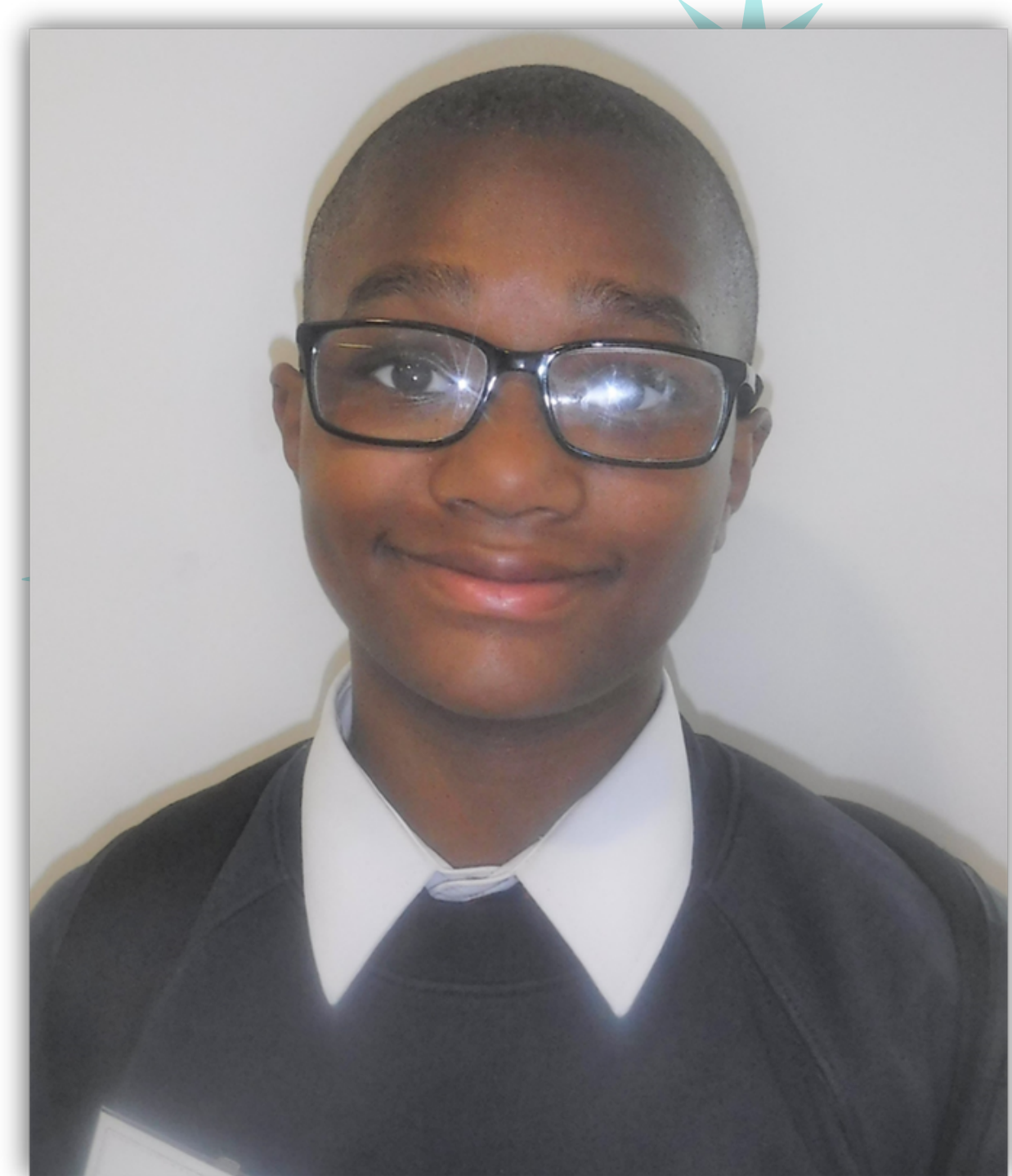


Nathaniel 7MA

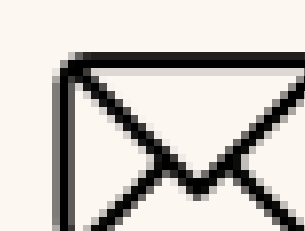

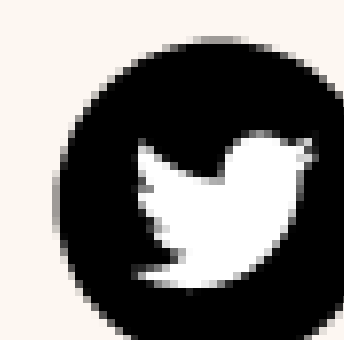

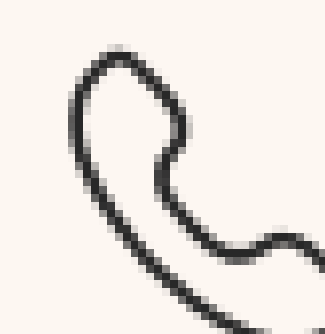
