

Careers Week

This week it has been National Careers Week and here at Stormont we have had lots of fun careers trips, Careers Assembly, Alumni talks and lessons to help our students explore the world of work.

We started the week with an amazing talk in the Whole School Assembly from Brett one of our Alumni who now has a full-time job at Chessington World of Adventures as a Ride Operator. He gave a fantastic talk about his career journey and gave students the opportunity to ask him questions about his experiences.

On Tuesday 10W and 11A got the opportunity to go to a behind the scenes Visual Effects Insight trip at the new ABBA Voyage Arena. Students got to talk to industry professionals from Industrial Light & Magic, who have worked on films like the Harry Potter and Star Wars series. Students also got a preview of the ABBA Voyage live show and got to see ILM's computer-generated clones of the band ABBA, designed to look and sound like their 1979 selves.

On Thursday some of our Year 11's had a visit to BSix for a college tour and over the next few weeks Yr 11 students are visiting various colleges to confirm the college they would like to attend and the course they are interested in for when they go to college in September 2023, as part of the schools Yr 12 programme. Parents/Carers will have the opportunity to say if they agree with the proposed college courses for their child and college open event dates will be shared with Parent/Carers who would like to see the colleges.

Also on Thursday we had another of our Alumni in, Natalie, to talk to Yr 9 about Supported Internships and her Careers Journey. Natalie is now a Co-Trainer for Mencap where she did a Supported Internship herself. She now talks to bug business, like Google, about how their companies can be more inclusive.


