### English /Literacy

**Topic**: The Wind in the Wil-



# Suggested ideas for home:

Students could watch a film/animation version of the story and make a poster or mini book about the story or one of the characters. They could read a version of the story at home.

### Maths

### **Topic:** Time and Money Suggested ideas for home:



Time some of your child's favourite activities to help them connect with the passage of time – do some baking together and set the oven timer, announce that their programme will be on the TV in 10 minutes and set an alarm or stopwatch.

Practice counting up in 5, will help when learning to read the clock and as a revision of the 5 times table.

When you go shopping, give your child some money and let them find something that they can buy with that small amount of money. If there is change, work out together how much change they get.



Topic: Keeping safe: Medical drugs Suggested ideas for home:

Talk to your child about medicines and drugs you have at home to help keep the family safe such as paracetamol, cold and flu capsules. Ask your child to make a presentation they can share at school on helpful medicines and drugs.

### Science

**Topic:** classifying rocks and making sounds



### Suggested ideas for home:

Visit the science museum or natural history museum and use the visit to take photos you can add to the school website or a presentation project. Look around your home and local area for different types of rocks and objects that make sounds.

Suggested ideas for home: Look at games you have at home and look at the material it is made from. You could try designing and making your own, add shading and colour or draw it up in PowerPoint.

### Suggested ideas for home:

Make your own musical instrument at home. Watch YouTube clips of an orchestra. If you are lucky enough to see a real orchestra make a presentation about your visit.

**Topic:** International Foods

### Suggested ideas for home:

Help your family with the weekly shop and cooking at home. Try a new food you can tell the class about.
