Notification of Results

Thursday 24 August 2023 is National GCSE/IGCSE results day. Admin staff will be in School to issue your results for GCSE/ IGCSE and /or all other assessments (e.g. BTEC, functional skills level 1 & 2 and functional skills entry level assessments). The school will be open between **11am and 12pm only** for you to collect your results in person should you wish to. Please do not come into school before this time as your result packs will not be ready for collection. **Please also note that we cannot issue your results to anyone other than yourself without advance written permission.**



Stormont House School Uniform Policy

Pay360 Education Payments (formerly SIMSPay) service is ceasing on 31 Jul 23. After this point, it will not be possible to process any payment transactions using the solution. Please do not make any dinner money payments after this date.

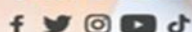
