Classical Meets Jazz Ensemble (CMJ) The Classical Meets Jazz (CMJ) programme

- was set up in 2016 by Hackney Music Service in partnership with LSO Discovery.
- The programme aims to respond to the underrepresentation of professional musicians from black and global majority ethnic groups, as well as those challenged by socio-economic circumstances, in orchestral and jazz ensembles. CMJ is holiday course based and works with young musicians of mixed age and mixed musical ability, and explores improvisation and ensemble playing through music influenced by classical and jazz repertoire. CMJ has performed at several prestigious events and venues including the Barbican, the EFG London Jazz Festival at the Southbank in the Clore Ballroom and the QEH as well as Hackney's annual Schools Music and Dance Festival. Since the programme was established, we have seen an increase in the diversity of membership to our own borough ensembles and have supported young people into the LSO East London Academy and other partnership groups.

Are you planning visits to the seaside over Summer? Here are some ideas for getting to the seaside

- [Broadstairs Viking Bay](#) - lovely sandy bay with lifeguards on duty and a 11 minute walk from Broadstairs station to the sea with Charles Dickens house overlooking the bay where he wrote David Copperfield. **Trains to Broadstairs run from Stratford International Station.**
