


<p>7NG Curriculum Leaflet</p> <p>Summer 1</p>  <p>Form tutor: Ms. Ngo</p> <p>Teaching assistants:</p> <p>Ms. Gould, Mr. Ramphul/Mr. Chapman,</p> <p>Tutor Time Focus:</p> <p>We will be using tutor time to develop out social interaction skills, such as taking turns and playing as part of a team.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>We will be learning about:</p> <p><u>Fantastic Mr Fox</u></p> <p>In depth reading of Fantastic Mr Fox.</p> <p>We will look at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Where the story is set - The different characters - The emotions the characters have - What the characters are thinking - Write a summary and a review 	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be learning about:</p> <p><u>Position and Direction</u></p> <p>We will be learning about positioning, movement and turns. We will be able to recognise positional language (on, above, beneath, next to etc) and describe movements and turns.</p> <p><u>Place Value</u></p> <p>We will be learning about place value of numbers and counting forwards and backwards, making our numbers, comparing numbers and partitioning them.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>We will be learning about:</p> <p><u>Acids and Alkalis</u></p> <p>We will be defining acids and alkalis, and identifying different acids or alkalis found in household items. We will be using the pH scale to explore the strengths of acids and alkalis and will make cabbage water to create our own PH indicator.</p> <p><u>Chicks</u></p> <p>We will be watching some chicks hatch in school this term. We will learn about chickens, the egg, the fertilisation and incubation and the hatching!</p>
<p>Religious Education</p> <p>We will be learning about:</p> <p>Norman Britain</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Battle of Hastings - When was Norman Britain - What was life like in Norman Britain – castles; feudal system; rulers; food; houses <p>Rivers/Local Area</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visit Stratford Canal – look at river parts; bridges; canals - Understand why rivers are important 	<p>Computing</p> <p>We will be learning about:</p> <p><u>Word Processing and Memory</u></p> <p>We will be learning to use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content in the context of using a word processing application to type a simple sentence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Typing on a keyboard - Typing symbols and saving files - Select, edit and format text 	<p>Personal Social Development</p> <p>We will be learning about:</p> <p><u>Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What a healthy diet would look like. - The benefits of keeping active physically and mentally - The importance of mental health - Personal hygiene - The importance of shared experiences - The importance of learning or mastering something. 	<p>Philosophy for Children</p> <p><u>We will be learning about:</u></p> <p>Using different books and stories to encourage the students to relate to their own life experiences.
