Tutor Time Focus:

Maintaining positive relationships

Behaviour for Learning Targets

English

We will be learning about:

The focus of this half term will be on preparing for the Step Up assessments that we will be doing in Key Stage 4. We will be concentrating on understanding different unseen comprehension texts. They will be building on their understanding of how to answer literal, inferential and predicting types of questioning.

Maths

We will be learning about:

Statistics – Probability

To understand the language of probability and use the probability scale. To list all the outcomes for single events and two successive events. To use estimates and probability fractions.

Geometry - Quadrilaterals

Understand and use the term 'quadrilateral' and the angle sum property of quadrilaterals. Understand and use the properties of quadrilaterals.

History

We will be learning about:

World War II

We will look at:

- The outbreak of the war – why it began, know the main countries involved and order key events
- The Home Front - describe how people on the home front contributed to the war effort during World War II
- The Armed Forces - describe the roles and responsibilities of the armed forces during World War II.
- The Battle of Britain – describe events of the Battle of Britain and explain why it was a turning point in the war.
- Key Events - describe what happened during some key events from World War II and order events on a timeline.
- The Holocaust - explain what the Holocaust was and describe some events that happened.

Science

We will be learning about:

This term Y9 will be learning about chemical reactions. They will look at different chemical reactions and reversible and irreversible changes. They will use scientific orks to talk about reactions and make simple word equations to describe the reactions they have seen. They will look at combustion and explore the fire triangle.

Computing

We will be learning about:

Pupils use MakeCode and the micro:bit to build practical projects while learning key computing concepts. They write, test and improve code using sequences, loops, inputs, outputs, variables, sensors and conditionals. By the end, they can create, debug and evaluate simple digital products confidently, with purpose.

We will be learning about:
