




Key Stage 4 Accredited Outcomes Summary 2025

Summary:

- There were 23 students in this cohort, with one student joining the school in KS4 and one who was educated offsite for the majority of KS4.
- Students worked towards accreditation in 10 subjects
- Of the 22 students on site 91% attained accreditation in 8 or more subjects.
- 95% of students passed Functional Skills or Entry Level Certificate in English and passed Functional Skills in maths.
- School self-evaluation is that these outcomes are consistent with the April 2024 judgement 'Pupils' outcomes are excellent. They make strong progress from their starting points across a wide range of subjects because of highly effective teaching'.



Further notes:

- One student was educated off site during most of Key Stage 4. This student is not in the numbers above as he had alternative provision provided through tutoring in Year 10 and Year 11. Whilst he only attained one qualification, he was working towards Entry level qualifications as well as how to successfully transition to another provision and is now engaged full time in college in year 12 where he will have more opportunities to attain those qualifications.
- Due to a change in qualification and changes in staffing students completed units in the WJEC ICT Entry Pathways qualification and will work towards claiming a qualification in Year 12.
- The student who entered the school in Key Stage 4 did attain two qualifications and will work towards English and Maths in Key Stage 5.
