




Key Stage 5 Progression Summary 2025

(From Year 12 Sixth Form to External Year 13)


Summary:

- The one-year Sixth Form Study Programme continues to be highly effective in preparing students for the next stage in their education and/or training, matched to each student's interests, abilities and needs
- All 24 students progressed to external courses/employment matched to their skills, interests and ambitions, including 3 who joined at the start of the year from other schools.
- There is a wider variety of colleges that students have progressed onto with more students changing college than is usual for Year 12 into Year 13. Two reasons for this are that BSix merged with New City College during 2024-2025 and they haven't offered appropriate level courses for some students whilst they settle and decide what the campus is going to offer. The other reason is that some students moved out of borough or moved to provisions in their borough.
- All students' progress will be overseen by monitoring visits and calls during Year 13.


