**10H braved a thrilling trip to The London Dungeons as part of their Crime Fiction studies in English.**

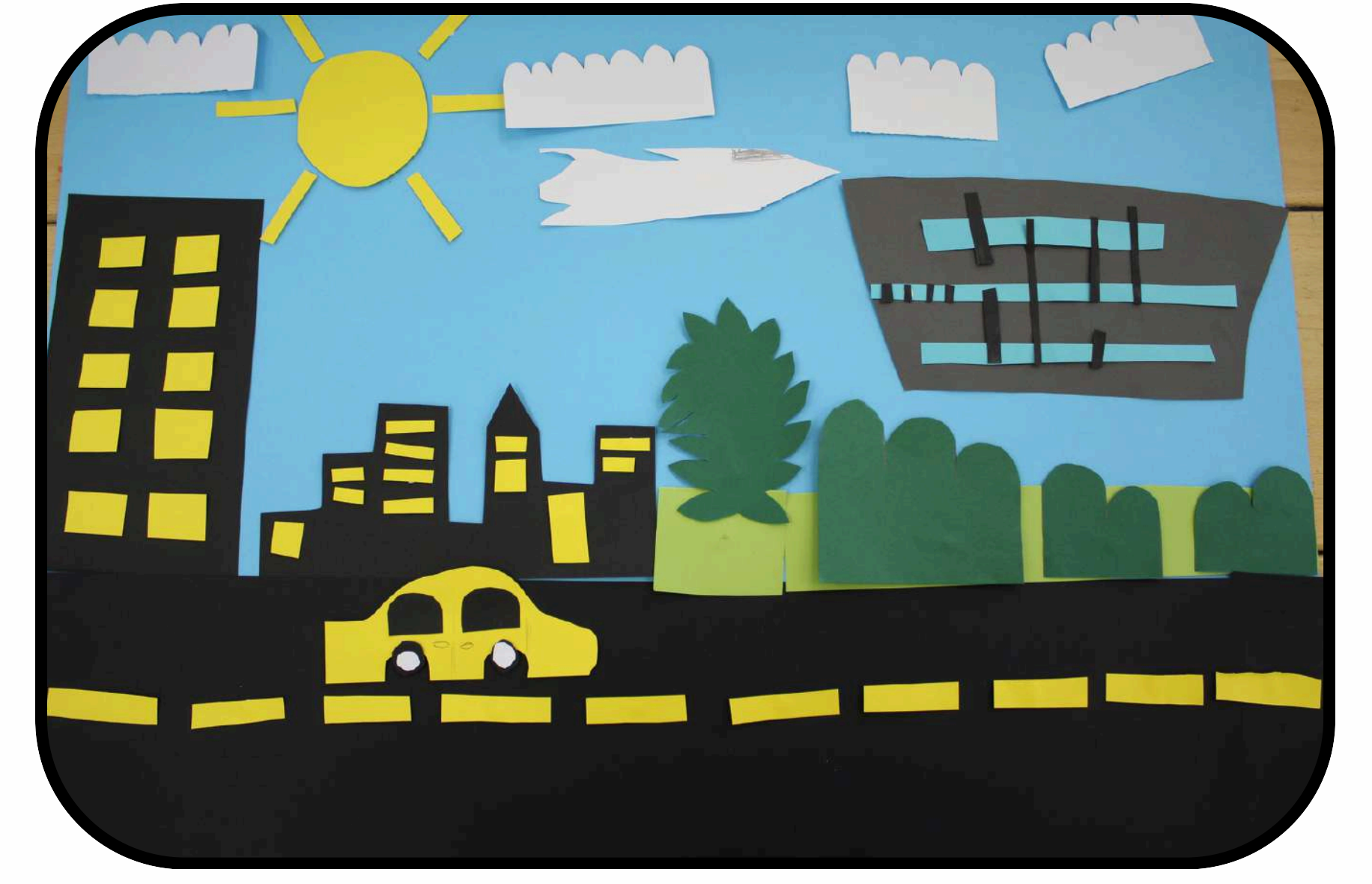
**Students explored London's dark history, discovering real crimes, characters, and stories through immersive, hands-on experiences — a perfect spark for their upcoming writing.**



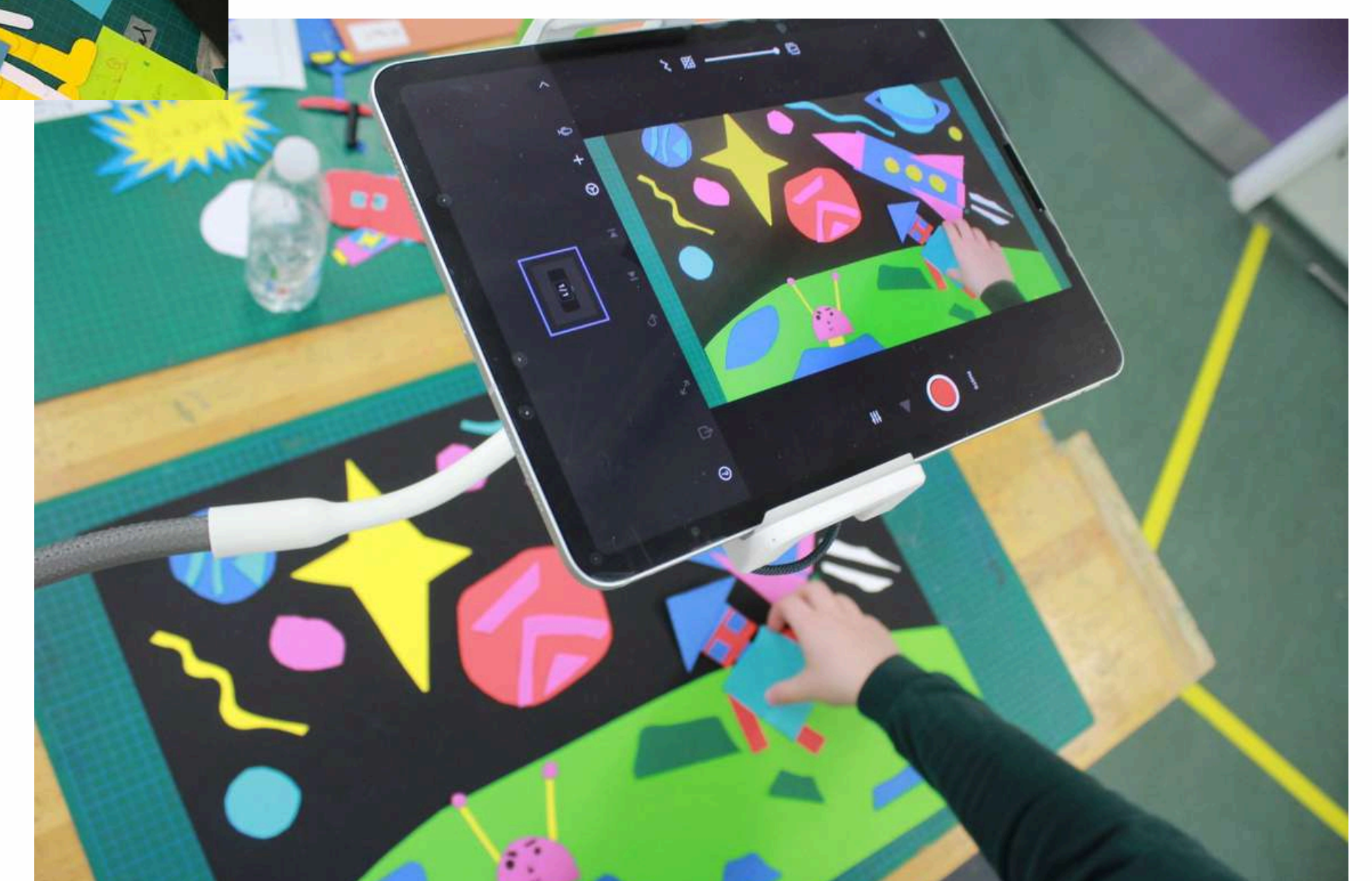
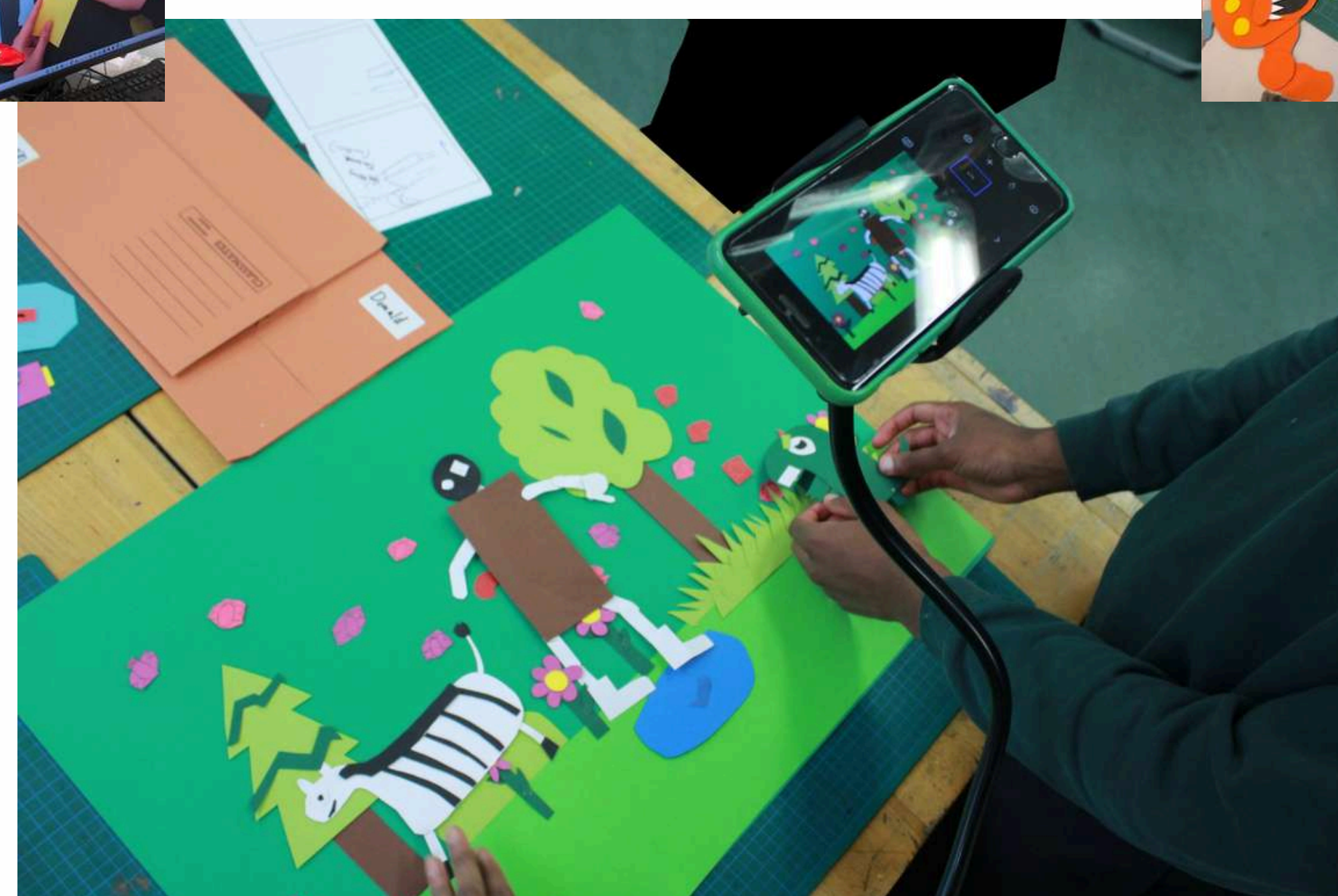
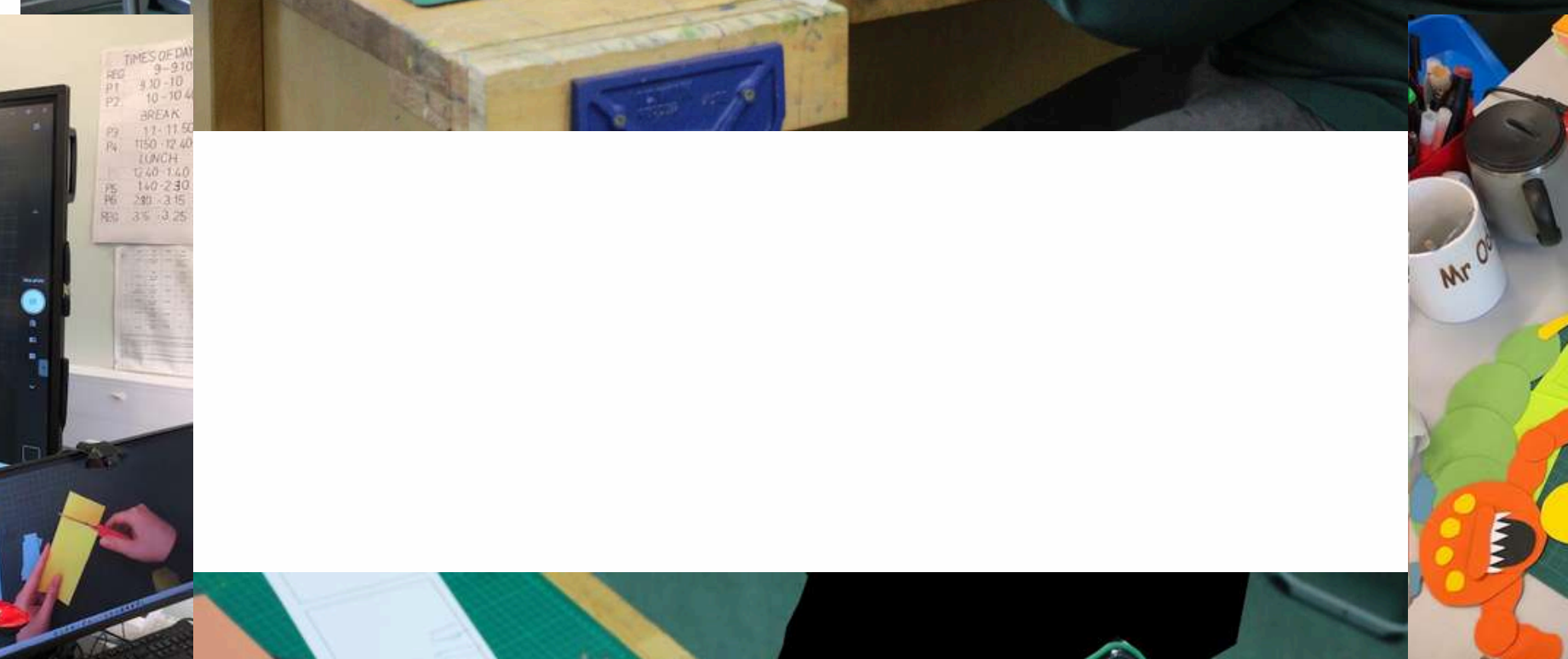
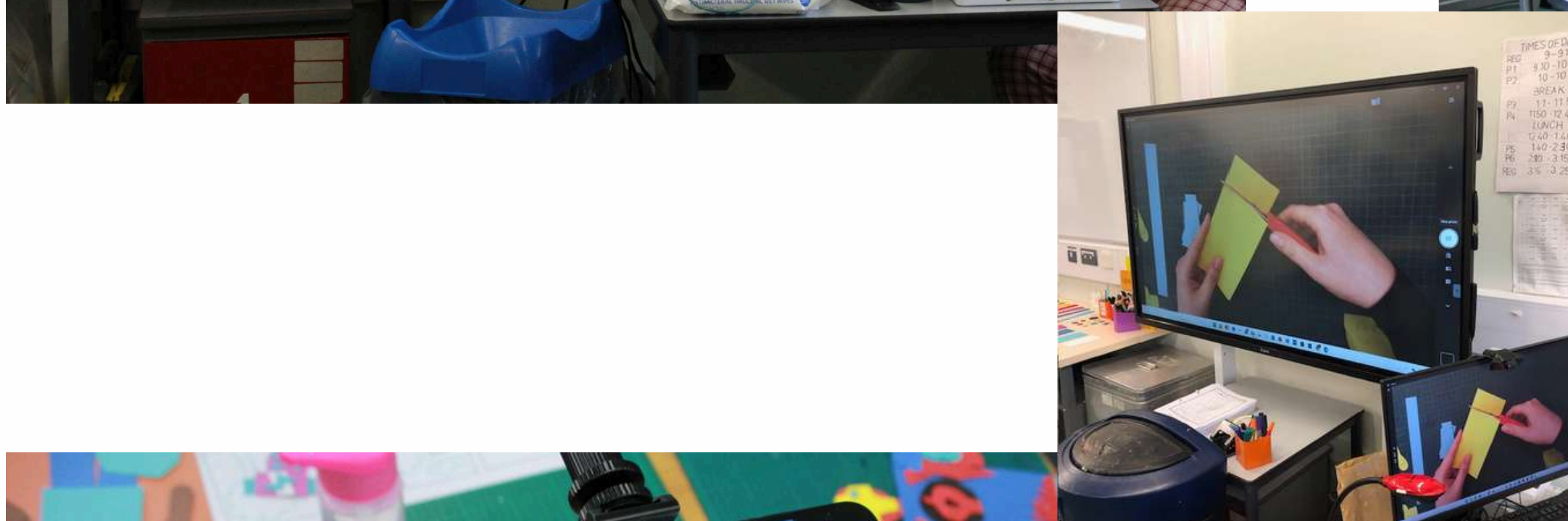
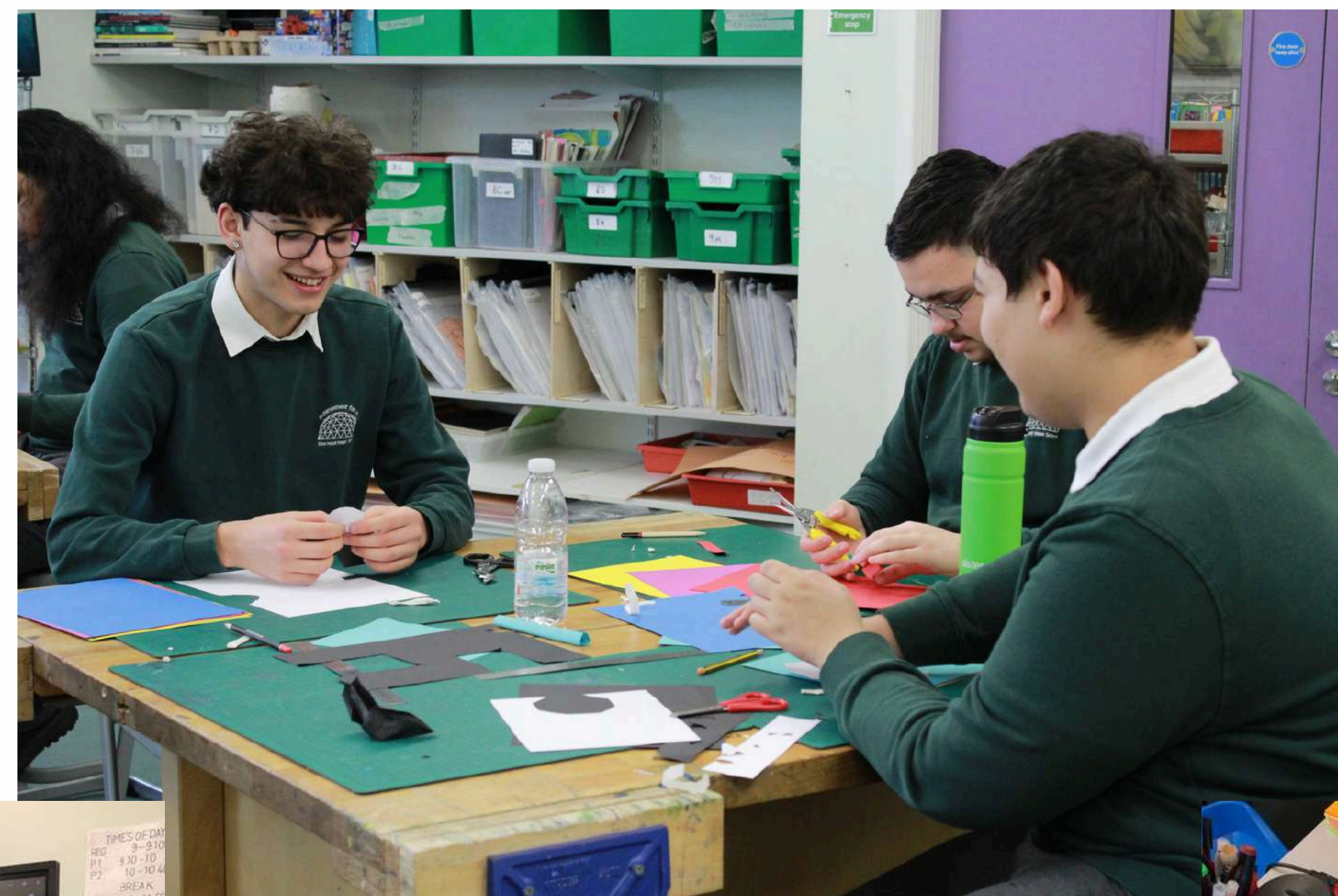
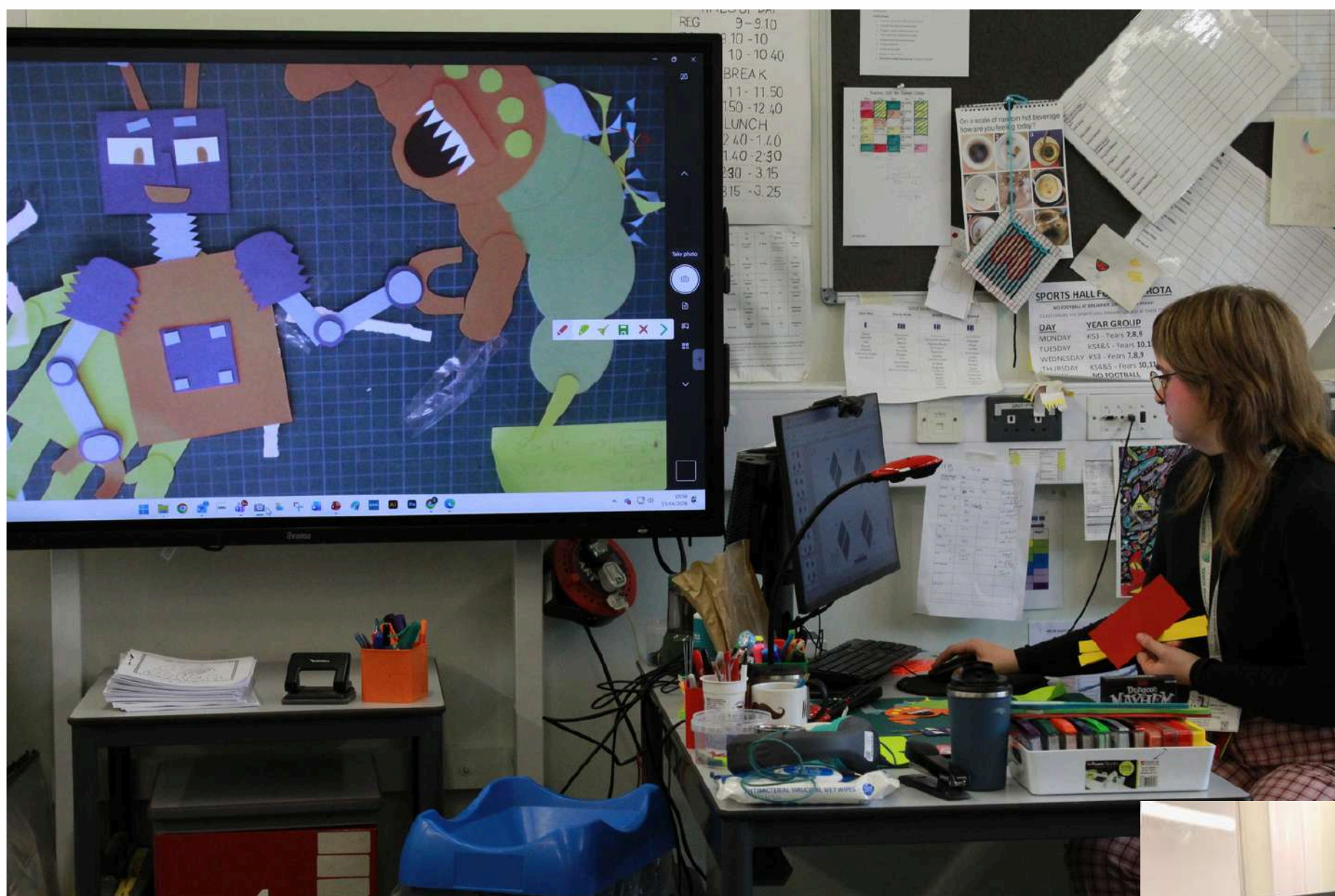
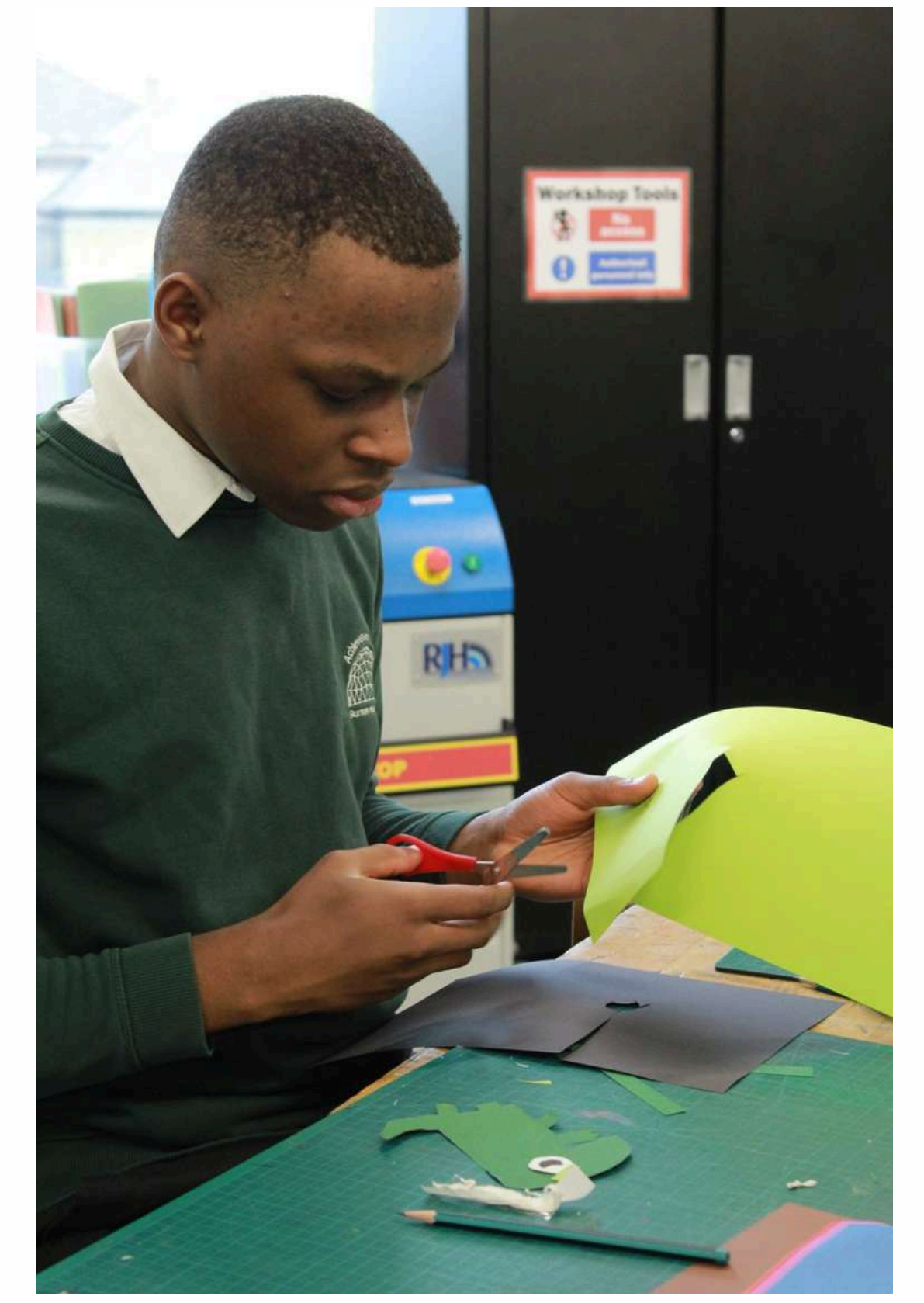
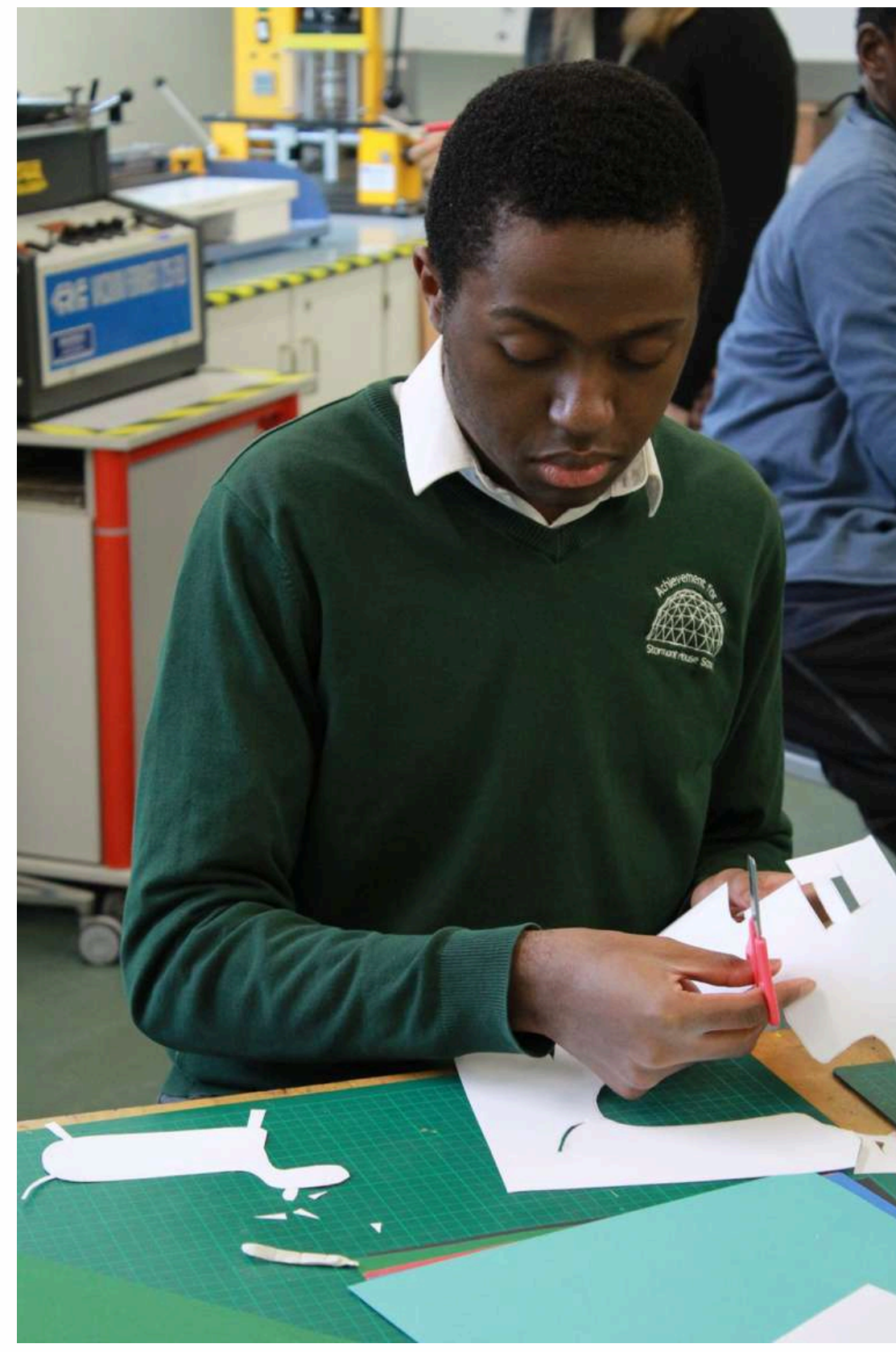
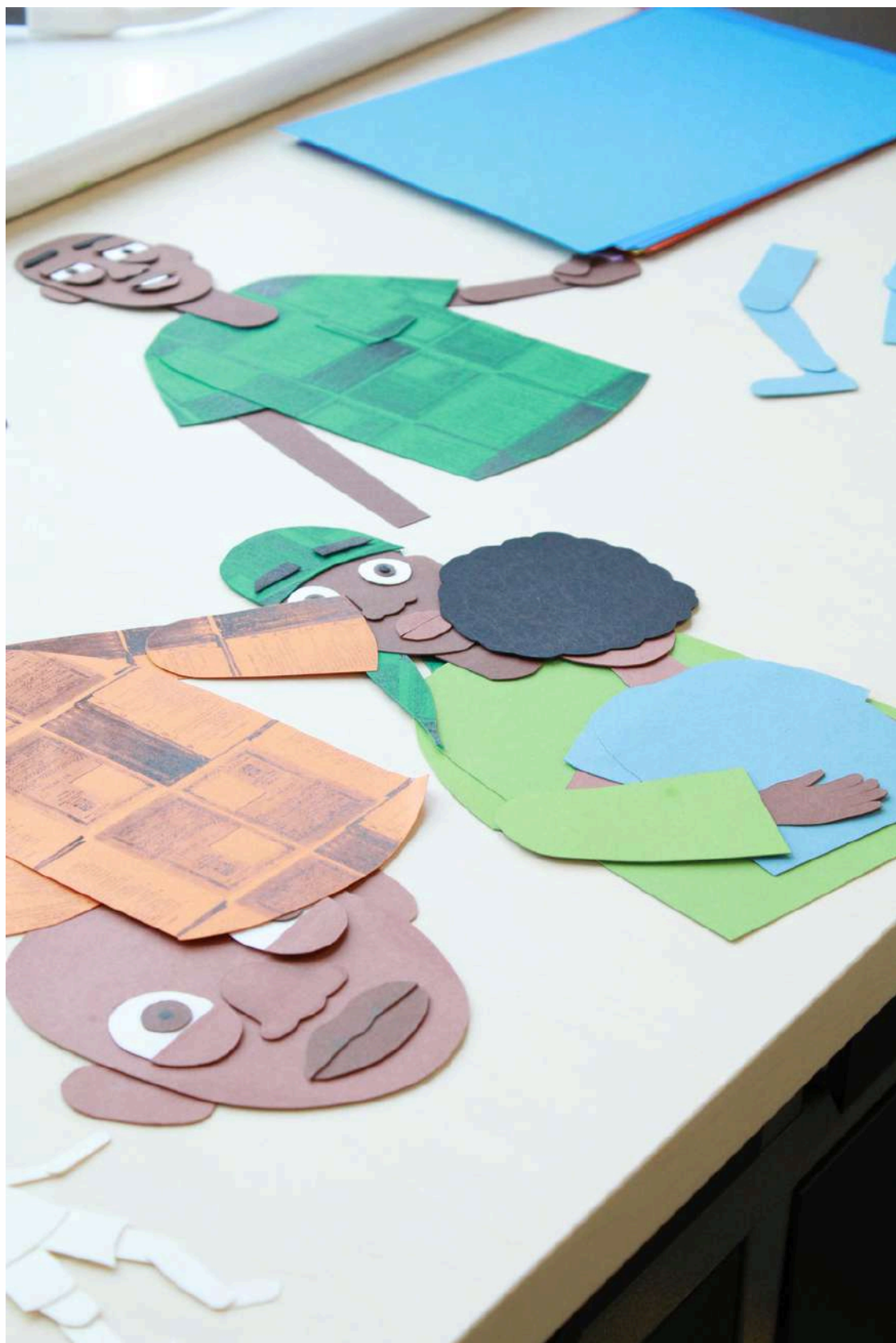
# Animation Workshop with Artist Burgie Jansen

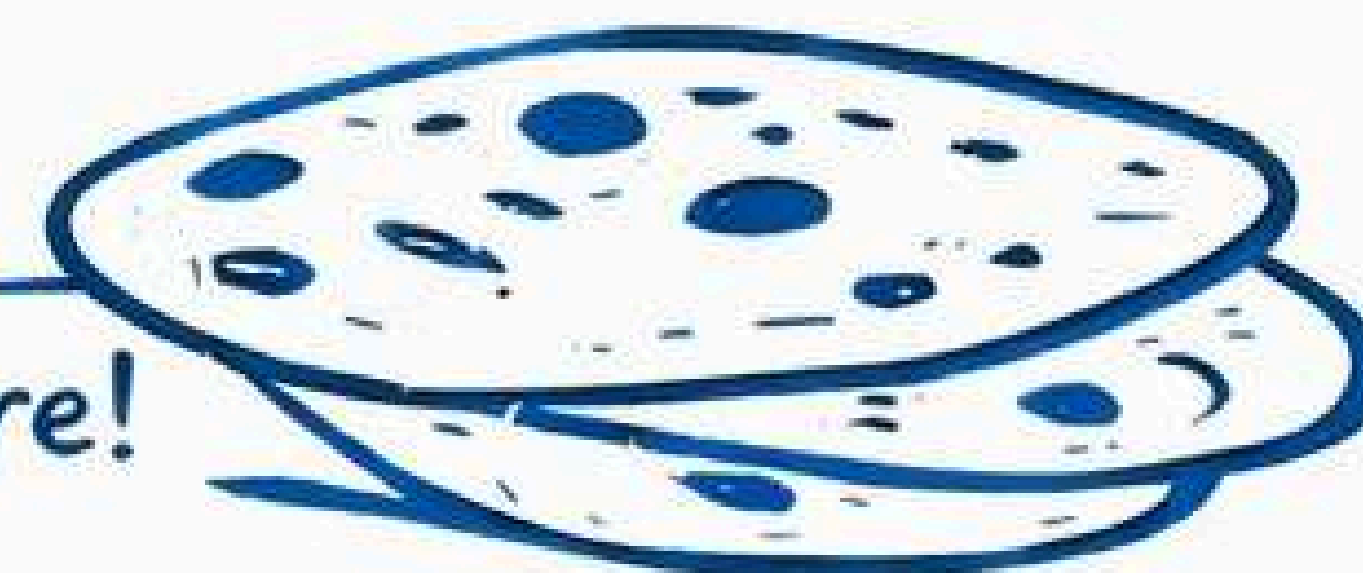
