


Police Update and Reassurance Regarding Recent Social Media Posts

Dear Parent / Carers,

We are aware that several schools, parents and carers in Hackney continue to express concern regarding recent social media posts encouraging serious youth violence. Similar posts have been seen referring to other boroughs as well. We have been informed by senior officers from the Metropolitan Police Service, who have provided reassurance, that a strong policing plan is in place both locally and across London to ensure the safety of our students and school communities.

The following statement has been issued by the Metropolitan Police across London.

Met Police Statement:

“We’re aware of social media posts circulating, and we are in close contact with schools and local authorities across various London boroughs to offer reassurance.

Officers will be visible around the specific schools named at the start and end of the day, and we will respond firmly to any reports of violence or disorder.”

Locally, Hackney Police have confirmed that:

- Emergency response and proactive officers are available across the borough to provide additional support where needed.
- Structured patrol plans are in place around Hackney schools, school corridors, and transport routes.
- Additional officers have been assigned to provide a dedicated rapid response capability should any incidents arise.
- The Metropolitan Police’s Intelligence Command is actively liaising with social media providers to remove harmful content and pursue those responsible for criminal activity.
- The Home Office is also coordinating wider action regarding the online encouragement of serious youth violence.

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
