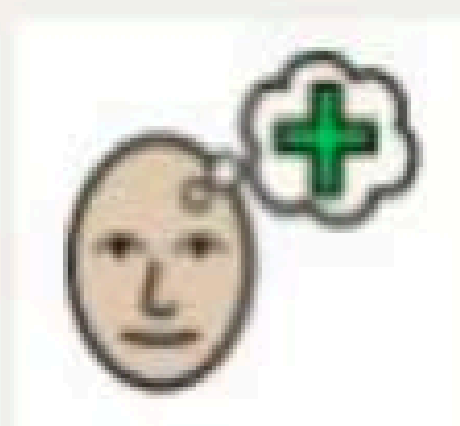
Friday 15th May is Non-uniform day!
