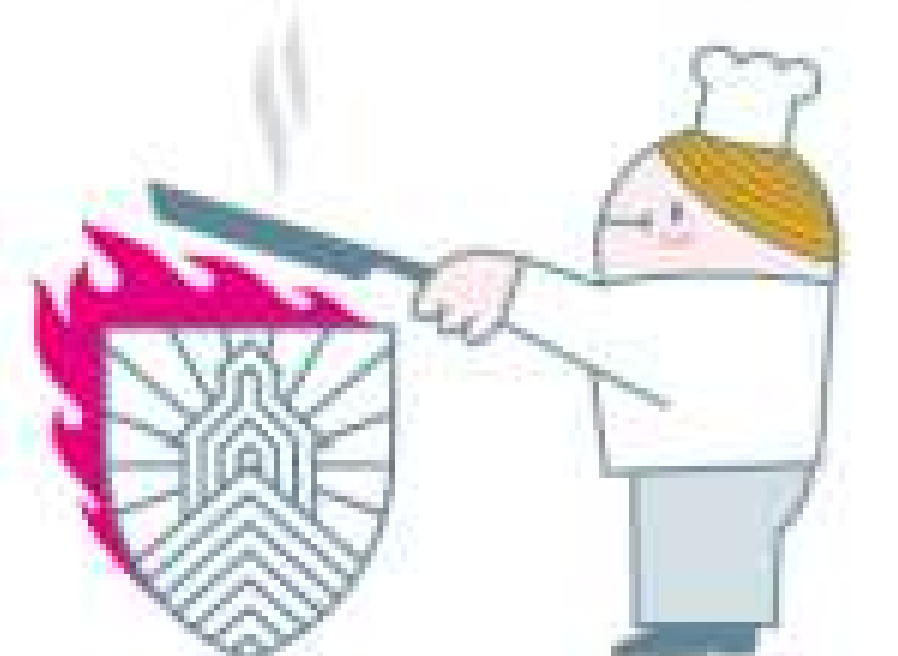

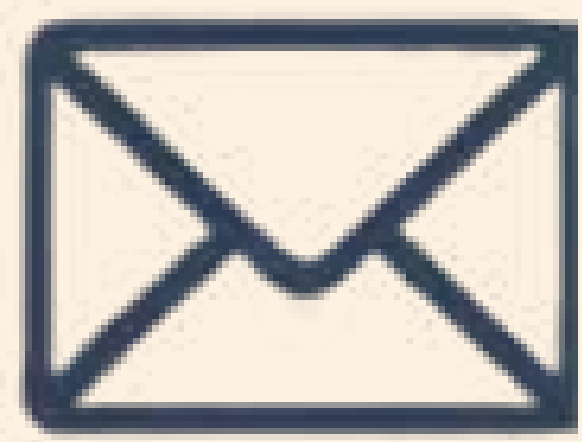

Parents will be informed by a member of the pastoral support team or a senior member of school staff if their child is involved in a serious behaviour incident.



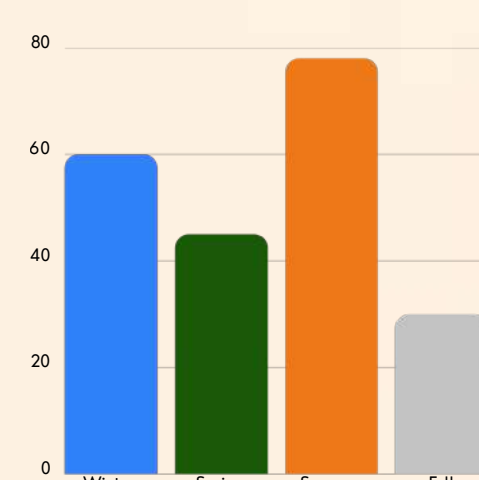
Form Tutor contact
