water bottle.



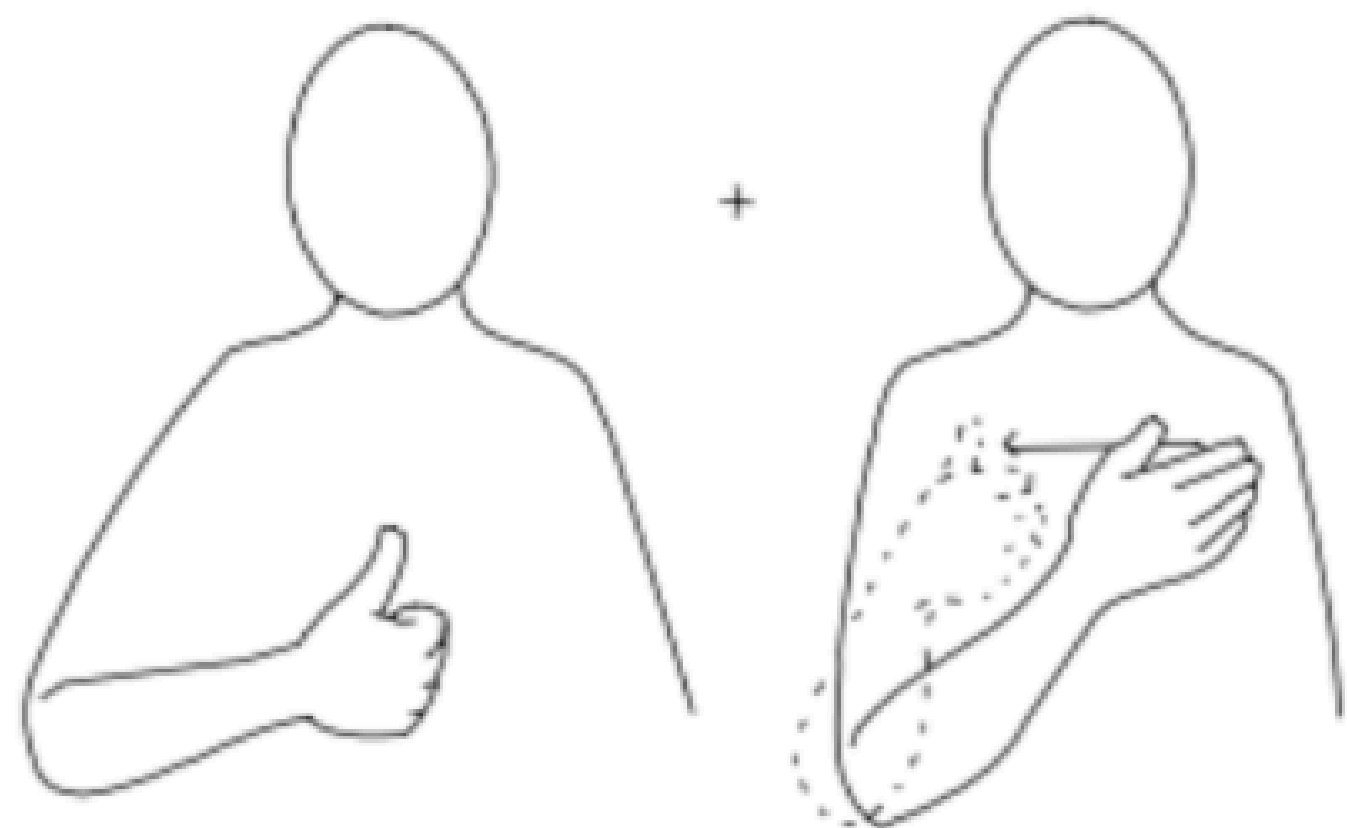
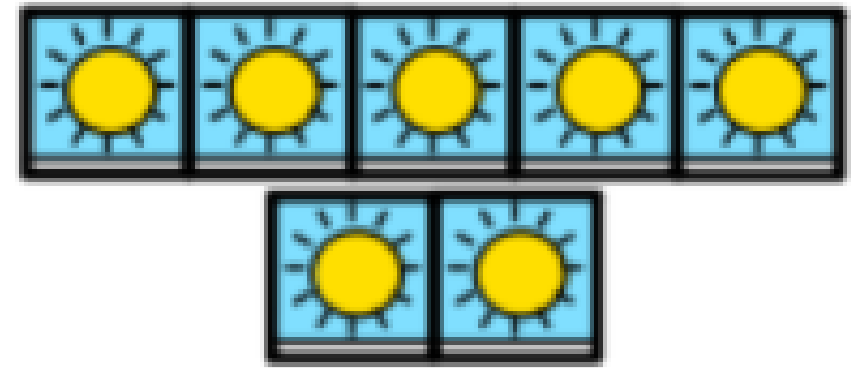
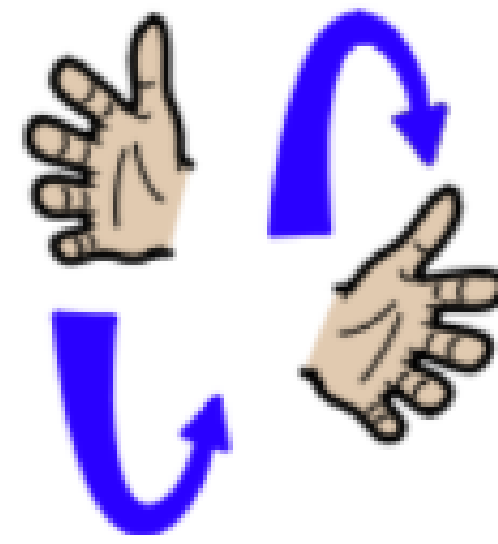

Help us shape the future of education in Hackney - A message from Jason Marantz, Director of Education

As you may know, in the last months, Hackney Council has been working on a new draft Education Strategic Plan for 2025-2028, which outlines the borough's top priorities for the next three years. We have shared the draft plan with you in July this year, inviting you to consider it and share your views with us, at bit.ly/educationplan2025.

The draft plan was developed after early engagement with families, schools, settings, and other partner organisations. The aim of the plan is to ensure Hackney's education offer is child-focused, strong, fair, anti-racist and inclusive, working in partnership to adapt quickly and respond to the changing needs of local children and their families. The consultation is still open until 22 September, so please send us your feedback if you haven't so far before that date.

The final Education Strategic Plan is expected to be published before the end of this year.
