'Books Uncovered' at the British Library

10M had a very successful trip to the British Library and we would like to thank parents very much for their support in preparing their children for this trip.

Everyone was very excited and well prepared: all 10M students knew where we were going and what we'd be doing once we got there. They knew our modes of transport and could recite the route to and from the British Library perfectly, and they followed all the safety measures in place.

At the library, we visited the treasures gallery: we saw the Magna Carta; some beautiful illuminated manuscripts, and two examples of 2,000 year old homework! We also went up to see one of the World's largest books, the Klencke Atlas, full of maps – which measures over 6' tall and more than 7' when it is opened.

The tour was followed by a 'Books Uncovered' workshop where the students learnt to make a bound book of their own. They had a lovely time following the instructions and getting creative; choosing various components; stitching their book together, and giving it a title.
