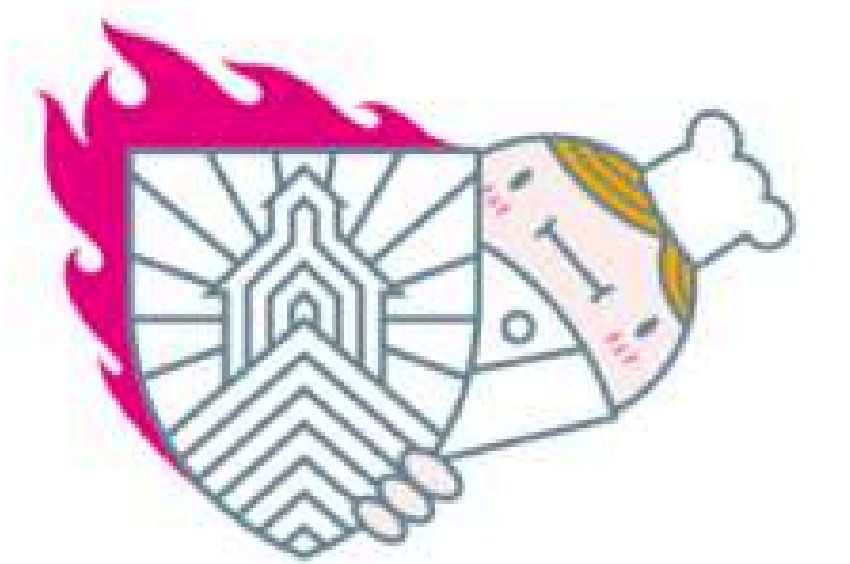

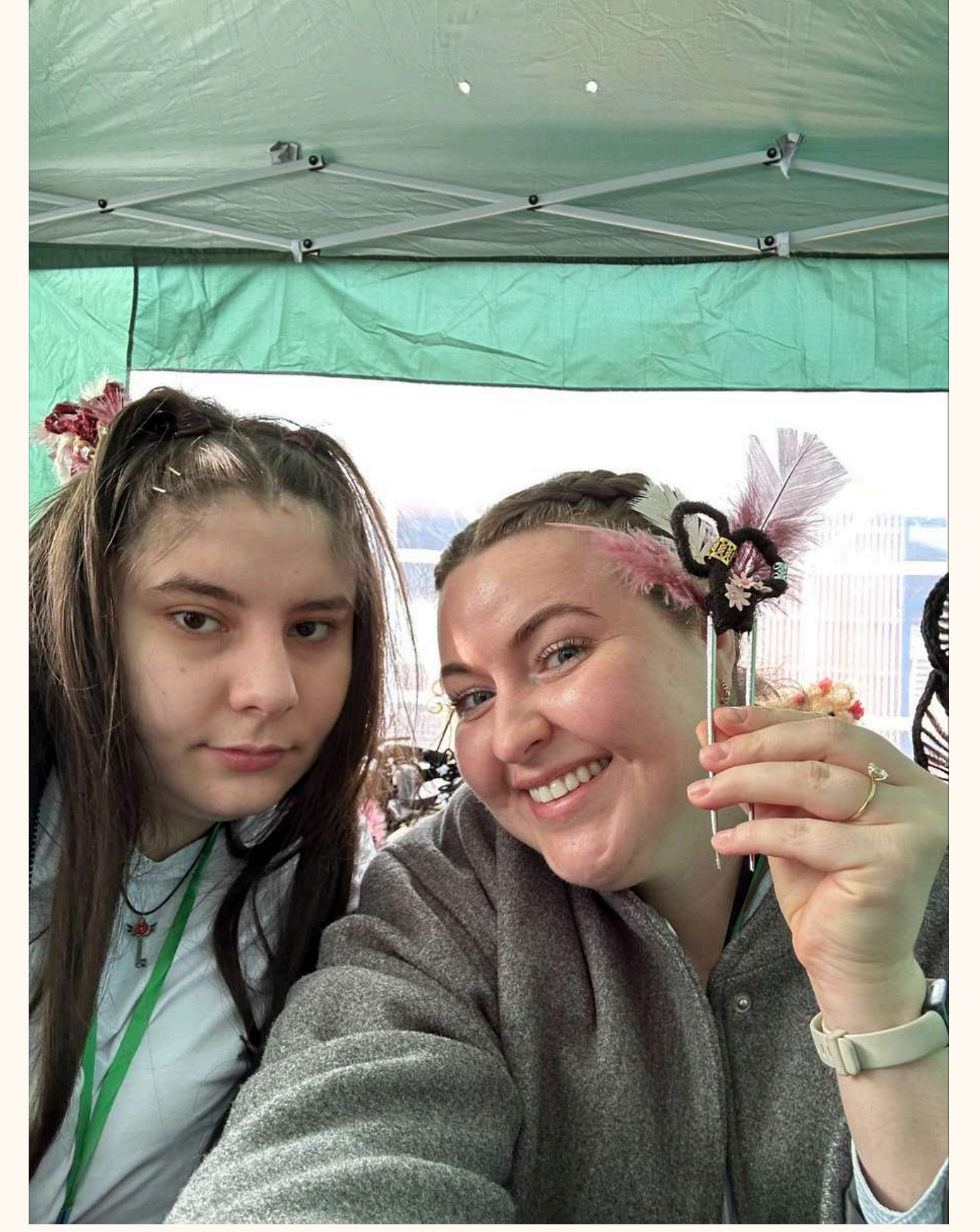

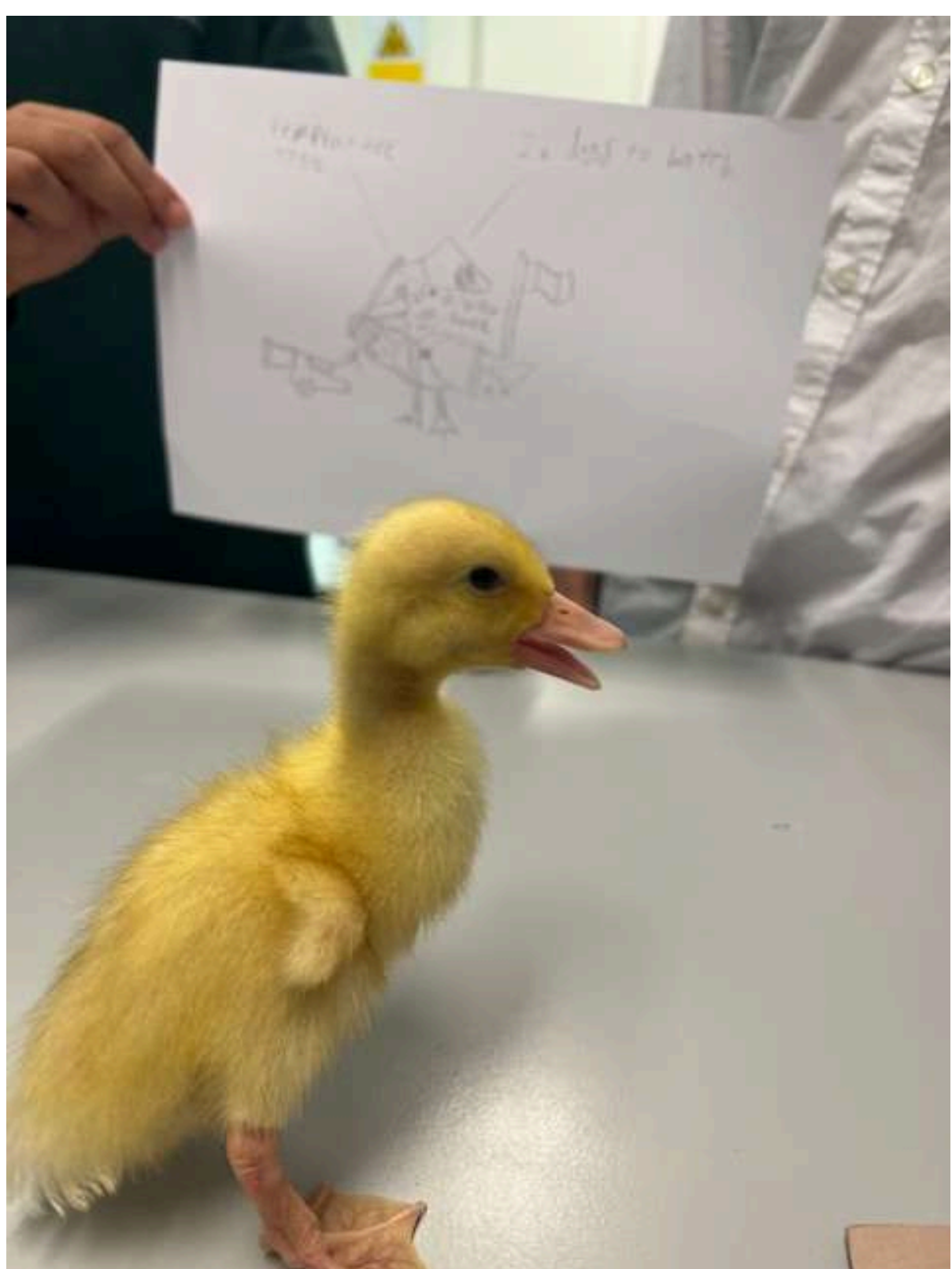


British Science Week

This was a great learning experience for students and lifted spirits across the school.

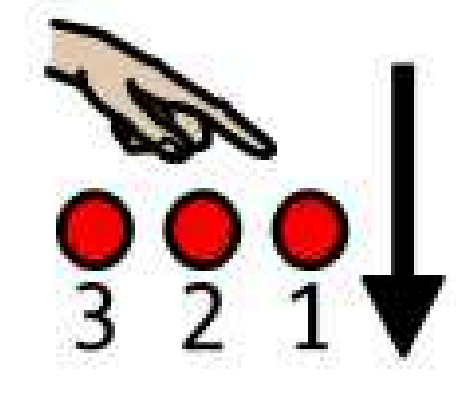




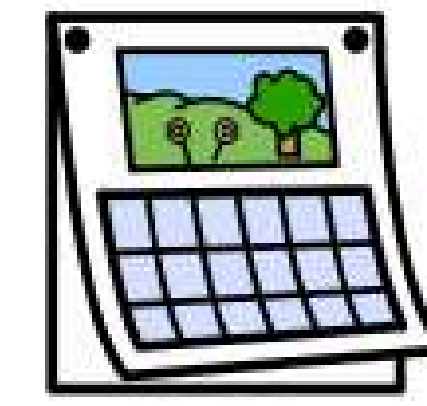
