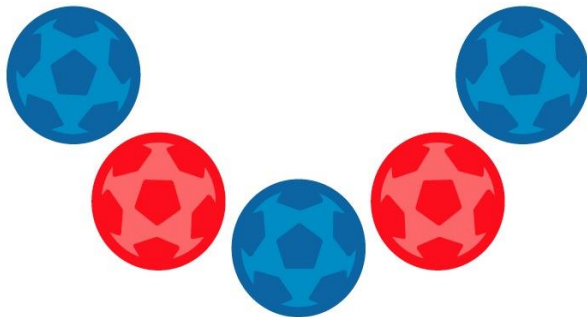


London Youth Games - Boccia



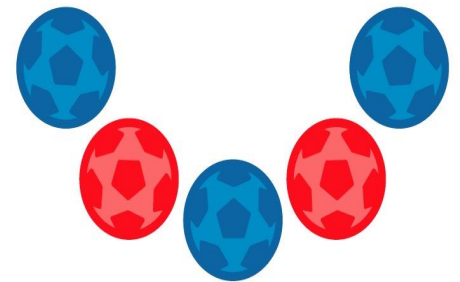
Boccia
