East London Regional Final - Panathlon Champions Competition

On Tuesday 26 March Year 9 plus Connor and Jordan from Year 10 competed in the East London Regional Final of the Panathlon Games at the University of East London's SportsDock facility which is located on the University's Docklands campus. Our team were representing Hackney and competing against teams from Newham, Waltham Forest and Barking and Dagenham.

The events which the teams competed in included new age curling, polybat table tennis, table top cricket, athletics and javelin. The team did exceedingly well in the table top cricket competition they achieved a gold medal. The team gained lots of medals in the athletics events, Tommy performed brilliantly to come first in the javelin event, and he received a gold medal for all of his efforts. All of the team performed to the best of their ability and were a credit to Stormont House.

After a very tough competition the Stormont House team came in in third equal position with the Waltham Forest team. The point difference between the teams was very small - well done to all of the Year 9 / 10 pupils who took part in the competition representing the School and The Borough.



School Uniform Reminder and Clarification

Dark grey trousers or skirt

Plain white school shirt or plain white polo shirt

Bottle green V-neck jumper with school logo OR Bottle green sweat shirt with school logo

- No other sweatshirts, jumpers or other tops can be worn over the sweatshirt /jumper with the school logo.
- Hooded tops of any description, or tracksuit tops etc. are not permitted except during PE lessons. (PE kit to be introduced later this year after consultation with parents/carers)

Plain black shoes for everyday wear (not trainers)

- Shoes may not have other colours apart from on the sole.
- Pupils should wear trainers for PE. These can also be worn if playing football etc. on the playground.

A suitable outdoor coat, preferably of a plain colour, which must be removed when in lessons, assembly or the dining room

• Hooded tops, tracksuit tops etc. do not count as suitable outdoor coats, nor should they be worn in school

A bag to take homework, pencil cases and other equipment to and from school.
