Several students were able to participate in a 'Have a go' DJ workshop led by Millie Cooper from 'The Elfrida Society'. The students experienced using decks to create their own music helped by two professional DJ's. All of the students had a great time creating their own tracks.



Ms Cooper runs the Junior Wild Bunch sessions at The Emirates Stadium, which are accessible parties for young people with learning disabilities to enable them to socialise, dance and have some fun outside of school time. The club is run by young people with learning difficulties for 10 to 19 year olds, their friends and families. The club includes:

- 2 great rooms of DJs, dancing and music overlooking the pitch at the Emirates Stadium
- Free entry on the door, refreshments
- Sensory/ chill out room
