Hackney Jack Petchey Regional Award Ceremony

The Jack Petchey Foundation was established in 1999 to support organisations that work with young people aged 11-25. Since its formation over £85 million has been distributed to schools, youth clubs, scouts and guides groups. The Jack Petchey Foundation's aim is to invest in youth organisations and programmes that represent value for money and create inclusive and positive opportunities for young people to engage, excel and achieve.

Williams Lea Mentors



A team of Mentors from our Business Partners, Williams Lea, come into school regularly to work with Year 10 pupils, helping them to broaden their understanding of the world of work. We currently have 12 mentors who visit our school. When they arrive they are greeted by Year 10 pupils who also provide refreshments for them. They then work together, on various work related issues, for example preparing them for their Internal Work Experience, and developing strategies to cope with the interview process that will help them in later life. The pupils also get to spend a day with the mentors in their work place in the City, where they follow the mentors through a usual working day pattern. Williams Lea has been working with the school for many years now, in fact some of the individual mentors have been coming in to school for over twelve years. They volunteer for the scheme and are very committed to helping our pupils. The mentors attend various functions at our school including Record of Achievement Day and Christmas lunch. Because of the excellence of their work the mentoring team won The Learning Trust Educators Award for Best Educational Business Partnership.
