Attendance/Punctuality: Be on time for Learning

Every pupil should attend school regularly. We are pleased to see that for the first part of half term 71 pupils had more than 95% attendance, with 43 pupils having a 100% attendance record. Are you on Benefits? Don't Bury Your Head in the Sand.

The government is making major changes to the benefits system and you may get LESS MONEY from April 2013.

Does this affect me?

The main change is the government "capping" the amount of money a family can get from benefits to a maximum of £500 a week. This includes your housing benefit and just about everything else. (There are a few exceptions). Phone the DWP helpline on 0845 605 7064 for more information

What do you need to do?

- People on Working Tax Credit are not affected by the benefit cap. So, increase the hours you work to at least 16 hours a week for lone parents and 24 hours a week for couples (with one partner working at least 16 hours). Then you are likely to be able to get Working Tax Credit.
- If you have a high rent, you might want to negotiate with your landlord to bring it down. Hackney's Benefits Rent Shortfall Team may be able to help with this call 0208 356 3923 or 0208 356 2449 to arrange an appointment
