Schools Meals: Price Increase

The cost of school meals will increase from £1.70 per day to £1.90 per day with effect from 1st September 2014, the first increase in six years. Included in this cost is free breakfast for all pupils and a piece of fruit at morning break time. The Governing Body approve a subsidy each year to enable us to maintain low cost while offering healthy options.

Dinner money is payable each week in advance (£9.50 per week). Please ensure it is clearly labelled with your child's name and class.
