

Using scientific techniques the students investigated a crime scene, identified clues and evidence – fingerprints / identified hair and fibres / investigated blood, bones and DNA. In their lessons the students undertook a variety of exciting sessions including: Looking at body cells / creating crime scene music / making ransom money and notes / crime scene reporting / making body plaster reliefs / crime scene photography / code breaking / kidnap trail / scavenger hunt.
