## Hackney Museum Trip Celebrating Black History Month 2014

As part of the Black History Month celebrations, Yr 9 went to the Hackney Museum on Mare Street where they explored an exhibition on a famous photography shop from the 70's. The shop was called Gibson's and everybody around Hackney used to go there to get their photo taken. They saw lots of different pictures of Afro-Caribbean people, striking a pose in their best clothes to send a picture of themselves from London back to their home. They saw pictures of weddings, family portraits, children, nurses, all sorts of people from East London. After exploring these fabulous pictures, the group watched an actress re-enact her own experience at the photographer's. She shared memories from her past: The pupils handled a coco bean, some tamarind, she read a letter sent by her grand ma to her mum, they tried on hats from her mum's time, back in the 50's. As you can see from the pictures below the pupils had their own pictures taken in a reproduction of Gibson's studio; it was a very informative and enjoyable trip.
