

Key Stage 5 Accredited Outcomes Summary 2017

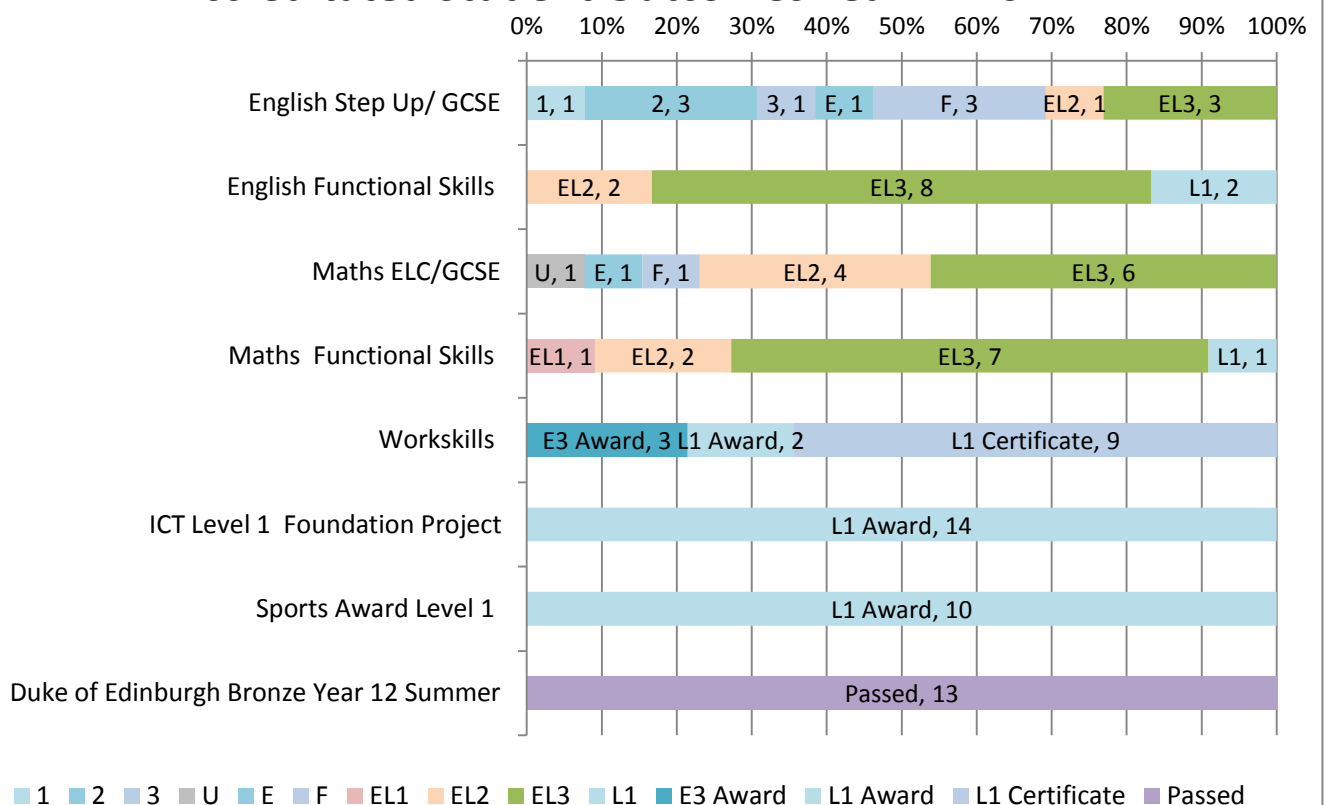
Summary:

- The one year sixth-form programme is highly effective in deepening and extending students' portfolio of experiences and accreditation in order to secure progression matched to their interests, abilities, needs and ambitions
- The very large majority (85%) continue to make sustained progress towards the next level of accreditation in English and the large majority (73%) in Maths as shown by school tests under exam conditions
- External Quality Assurance of student outcomes by the LA School Improvement Partner in December 2017 verified the school's self-assessment judgement of 'outstanding'

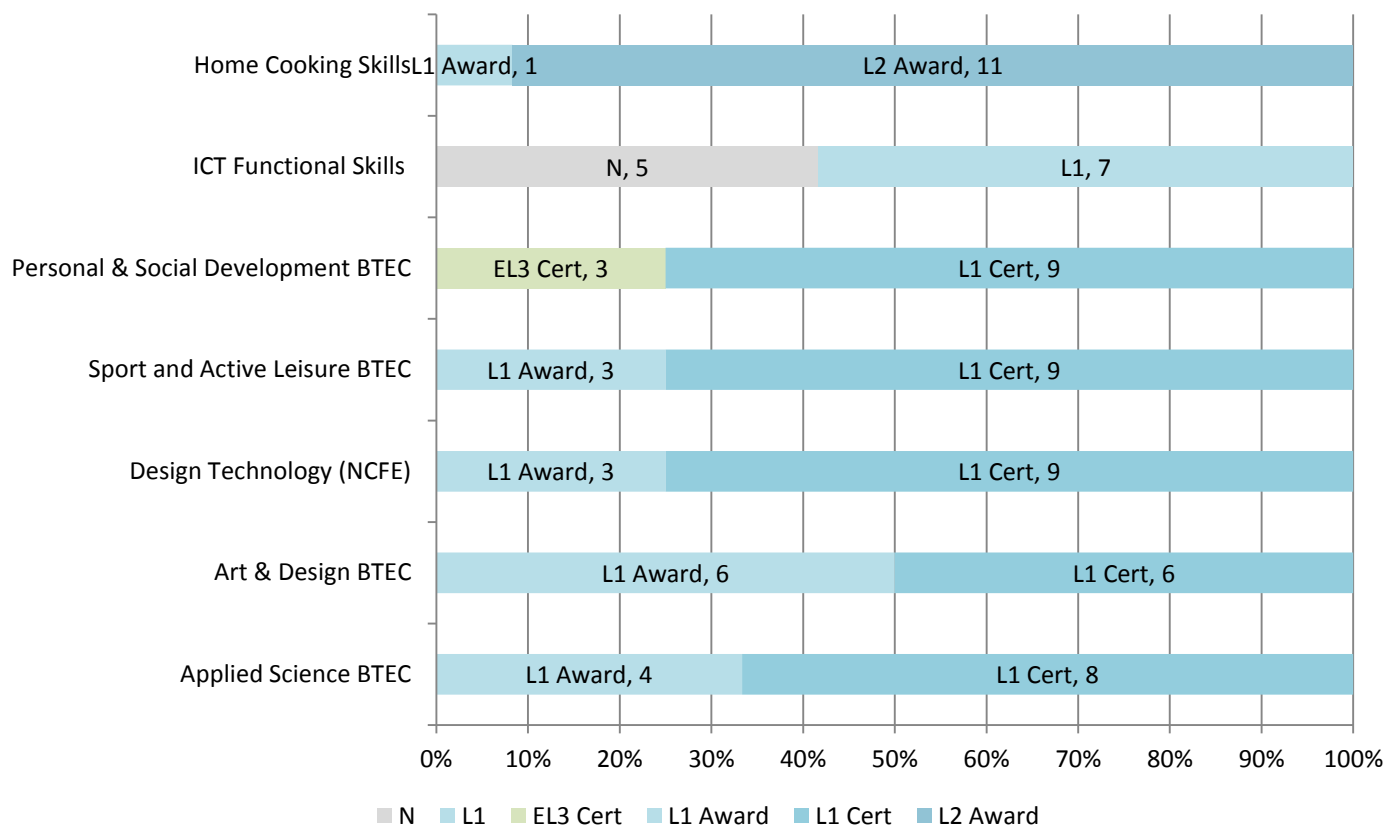

Approximately 75% of accreditation achieved by our students is 'discounted' from inclusion in the Progress 8 and Achievement 8 measures. Although these measures may be useful for comparing mainstream schools, they do not provide useful data in our context due to this discounting and the lack of reliable baseline data.
