Most of the bedrooms are not lockable and contain bunk beds. Each family would be given their own room unless they agree to share with another family. There are wash basins in all rooms plus separate male/female showers and wc's.

You can travel to Kench Hill independently / join the accompanied group on the train from Stratford International / there is a possibility that a coach from Hackney may be arranged. If accessible transport is required please contact Kench Hill to discuss your needs.
