Students were encouraged to explore the galleries and take photographs to inform ideas for their own sculpture ideas which the will design and make later this term for their BTEC Art & Design brief.


This trip helped to develop the students' concepts of different types of sculptures from traditional to the abstract.




Year 7 Parent / Carer Coffee Morning Ocean Maths Workshop
