

Nearly all the students completed an online programming course and received certificates for their hard work Eight lucky students who made the most progress where also selected to receive a tiny programmable computer, 'The BBC Micro Bit', to keep and pursue their learning at home. The school will be making more of these available to students who continue to show an interest in programming.
