I am delighted to inform pupils, parents and carers that the government have agreed to fund the new Stormont House School, which will be built on our existing site. Before the new school can be built, we will have to move everything to our 'decant' site in July 2012, where we will stay until Christmas 2013. During this time we will be at Mount Pleasant Lane, E5 9JG. At the moment the site is being used by Our Lady's Convent High School while their new school is completed.

Because of the amount of time it will take to move out of this building and into the decant school, including repairs and testing at Mount Pleasant, we will need to finish the summer term for pupils approximately 1 week early, and start again in September approximately 1 week late. ### **Art Lights London – GAMES Neon Sculpture**

In April / May 2010 the present Year 10 took part in the 'GAMES' Olympic art project organised by the Art Lights London team. They worked with a neon light artist called Ron Haselden, the pupils participated in two half day workshops, they were asked to produce a sequential strip of drawings on the theme of the GAMES. Five other schools worked on this project, one from each of the five Olympic boroughs. All of the pupil's drawings were exhibited at Stratford Circus. Ron and a panel from Art Lights London shortlisted 10 drawings.

The winning drawing was produced by Aaron in Y10 his drawing has been made into a neon light installation by Ron Haselden. This is being built onto a crane and will be erected at Diespecker Wharf in Islington in a small section of canal between City Basin and Islington tunnel. Art Lights London has organised an opening event on February 2nd, all pupils who took part in the project are being invited to attend the lighting ceremony.

The ceremony starts at 5.00pm, Peter Waterfield, a member of the British Olympic Diving team will be switching the lights on at 6.30pm after a question and answer session with Ron Haselden.
