As part of their Art project Year 8 have been designing and creating sculptures of man-made objects which they have covered with a natural surface. One of the artists they researched was Kate McGuire. She predominately uses feathers as a medium for her sculptures. Ms Elford had contacted the artist via her website to ask if she would answer some of Y8's questions regarding her work. Kate suggested that a small group could actually visit her in person at the gallery.







On February 13 a group of 12 pupils from Year 8 went to the gallery near Kings Cross to meet the artist. Kate showed them a drawing of a peacock feather that she did when she was their age. She also answered all their questions and discussed her exhibition work. Kate had also made a small piece of her feather artwork for the pupils to touch. Each week we have been focussing on year 11 pupils, giving us an insight into their work experience and how they felt it went: Today we are focusing on Pritesh from 11P:


