
Year 9 Conquer Edale: an incredible journey of self-discovery

Through our school sports programme Lily (10P) has developed a real skill and passion for tennis. She has built on this both in and out of school. Lily's success was recognised on Thursday 12 May when she was awarded the GLL Sport Foundation Top-Up Award at the Sobell Sports Centre.

Lily has won funding to help her with training and competition costs, including free training membership of GLL / partner managed sport and leisure venues for a year. Through this scheme Lily has free access to the GLL sport science support programme, which is supported by Middlesex University and London Sport Institute. Lily will be able to access One to One Athlete programme – access to a personalised 12 week performance / intervention programme to improve athlete sports performance.


