Please remember that your child will come to school on transport on Monday 19 May and will return on transport on Friday 23 May (Where applicable).


If you decide to bring your child into school on Monday 19 May and collect them from school on Friday 23 May - it is up to you to contact transport to inform them of your plans.


Proposed Expansion to Stormont House School
