We will be learning about:

Non-fiction: completing AQA Entry Level creative writing unit on the topic of Heroism. Reading a range of texts featuring heroes and producing our own piece of creative writing.

Weekly independent or guided reading in the classroom or school library.

Maths

We will be learning about:

Functional Skills Maths - Data

Sort and classify objects using a single criterion

Read and draw simple charts and diagrams including a tally chart, block diagram/graph Extract information from lists, tables, diagrams and bar charts Interpret information, to make comparisons and record changes, from different formats including bar charts and simple line graphs Sort and classify objects using two criteria

Science

We will be learning about:

'Motion and Pressure', Year 10 will be learning about speed, relative motion, and the impact of forces on objects that are moving and still. They will then move on to learn about pressure in liquids, and movement as the turning effect of a force.
