School Aged Vaccinations HPV and DTP/MEN ACWY

Catch Up Clinics

If your child is in secondary school and has missed the HPV (given in year 8) or DTP/Men ACWY (given in year 9) please attend 1 of our clinics below.

The HPV vaccine helps protect against cancers caused by HPV, including: cervical cancer, some mouth, throat, head and neck cancers. It can also protect against cancers of the anal, genital and genital warts.

It also helps protect against genital warts.

DTP - In total, you need 5 doses of the tetanus, diphtheria and polio vaccines through your childhood. This will build up and maintain your body's own immunity against these infections and protect you against the diseases.

The Men ACWY vaccine is given by a single injection into the upper arm and protects against 4 strains of the meningococcal bacteria – A, C, W and Y – which cause <u>meningitis</u> and blood poisoning (septicaemia).
