Mr Hajdrych Shortlisted for Balfour Beatty London Youth Games Award 2015

The Balfour Beatty London Youth Games Awards Evening took place on Thursday 8 October, it is a very special annual event and dinner where the London Youth Games Awards for the 2015 Season are presented. The award ceremony took place at the Underglobe on London's Southbank. Mr Hajdrych had been shortlisted for Team Manager of the Year.

The award ceremony was attended by a number of Olympians who were being inducted into the London Youth Games Hall of Fame, they included Siobhan Chamberlain who represents Chelsea and England at football. She competed for Wandsworth over a number of years at the London Youth Games in seven sports and Christine Ohuruogu who first took part in the Games for Newham at Netball, before running at the Games in her first race on a proper track.

Unfortunately the award for 'Team Manager of the Year' went to another nominee, but we are all very proud of Mr Hajdrych for being nominated for the award.







Flu Immunisation Programme at Stormont House School

Starting on Friday 13 November our school nursing team will be coming into school to start the Flu Immunisation Programme with our students. Letters, consent forms and information booklets were sent out before half term, if you would like your child to receive the Flu vaccine please either return the form to school or contact Mrs Napier as soon as possible.

The vaccine is given in the form of a nasal spray, which contains viruses that have been weakened to prevent them from causing flu but will help your child to build up immunity. When your child comes into contact with the flu virus they will be less likely to get ill.

There are no serious side effects from the vaccine, your child may develop a runny or blocked nose, headache, general tiredness and some loss of appetite, but this will only last for a few days.

Students should not have the Nasal Vaccine if they:

- are currently wheezy or have been wheezy in the 3 days prior to the vaccination
- are severly asthmatic e.g. being treated with oral steroids or high doses inhaled steroids
- have a condition that severely weakens their immune system or have someone in their household who needs isolation
- have severe egg allergy please check with your GP
- > are allergic to any other components of the vaccine

EU Stars Bronze Award

Stormont House School has been awarded the Bronze Award from the EU Stars Sustainable Travel Accreditation and Recognition for Schools. Mrs Napier attended the ceremony at the Jeffrye Museum on Tuesday 3rd November and accepted the award on behalf of Stormont House School.

The award was achieved by the hard work of the YTAs (Youth Travel Ambassadors) in 2014/15 - the ambassadors worked to put together a grant bid from TFL (Transport for London), they asked for a grant of £200 to enable the school to put on an active and independent travel and health awareness activity day on Friday 8 May 2015. In order to receive the grant the ambassadors had to create a pitch which was presented to a panel of EU Stars and TFL representatives - they included a video which they made entitled 'Be Active, Be Safe and Have Fun!'.

Well done to the YTAs from last year which included, Malachi, Shane, Brett, Tekia, James, George, Kian, Raheem, Muhammad, Jamie, Liam and Edward. The election of the new YTAs for 2015/16 took place before we broke up for half term - the results will be announced next week in the whole school assembly.
