Medal Success at National Indoor Junior Rowing Competition

For the first time in Stormont House history our students won 7 medals at the National Junior Indoor Rowing Championships, on Friday 28 February at the Copperbox. All the students performed fantastically, many of them beat their personal best results. DJ won a gold medal in the KS4 Boys event by rowing 576 meters in just 2 minutes! Leona and Aisha both achieved a distance of 473 meters which gave them both bronze medals in the KS3 Girls event (it is very unusual for two competitors to row the same distance – the girls logged the same distance when they were tested in school rowing trials - 465 meters!!). The competitors from Stormont were Aisha (Yr. 7), Leona (Yr. 8), Bobbi-May (Yr. 11), Pinar (Yr. 11), D'yah (Yr. 11), Kenneil (Yr. 9), Kishone (Yr. 9), Anthony (Yr. 9), DJ (Yr. 10) and Shay (Yr. 10). Mr Hajdrych was extremely proud of all the students, to compete at national level and win a medal is something very, very special. Well done everyone. The next rowing competition will be in the summer London Youth Games. Watch this space!
