Welcome back to School!

It has been an exciting week welcoming all students back in to school. Monday was the first time we saw all students in at once, back in their regular classes.



In support of Red Nose Day 2021 the theme in school this year is "**Funny is Power**." Our students have been finding their favourite jokes, practising how to deliver a joke, and creating "Share A Smile" posters to pass on the humour. Some students have 'become superheroes' and others have created red noses (with moustaches) for their face masks – "because you can't wear a red nose and a mask". Some students have created cards containing a joke and a letter to bring some happiness to people who have been made more isolated and lonelier due to Covid-19 restrictions. Many have chosen to 'dress up to donate' which means coming to school out-of-uniform and, where possible, wearing something red in order to help others.

Red Nose Day is a campaign with the mission to end child poverty by funding programmes that keep children safe, healthy, and educated. "Helping others" is one of our students' self-determined priorities at Stormont House and we are very proud of the generous spirit of our students.



Face coverings (masks) are compulsory for secondary age students unless they have an exemption. Please make sure your child has a comfortable mask to wear in class as well as moving around inside school.

Wear a vest! The government has asked us to open windows in all classrooms to reduce the risk of the virus spreading, so they may be colder at times than usual. Please make sure your child wears an extra layer under their shirt (e.g. a vest or plain white T-shirt.)

Named water bottle - please make sure your child brings a clean, reusable water bottle to school with their full name clearly marked on it.


The school day starts at 9.00am and finishes at 3.00pm for all students.
