Bobby

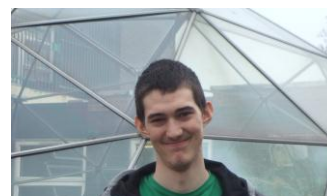

Cooking the Produce

Incorporating horticulture into the curriculum has helped to promote sustainability by providing food for the school. In their food technology classes, pupils have used peas for samosas, spinach for feta and spinach filo and courgettes for cous cous salad. All of these ingredients were home grown here at school.



Lettuce and courgettes which were grown in our school for use in our classes and for school meals, staff in our kitchen say they are very pleased with the vegetables given to them to use.

In the school kitchen the staff used spinach to make spinach okra rice, lettuce for salads and potatoes for roast.
