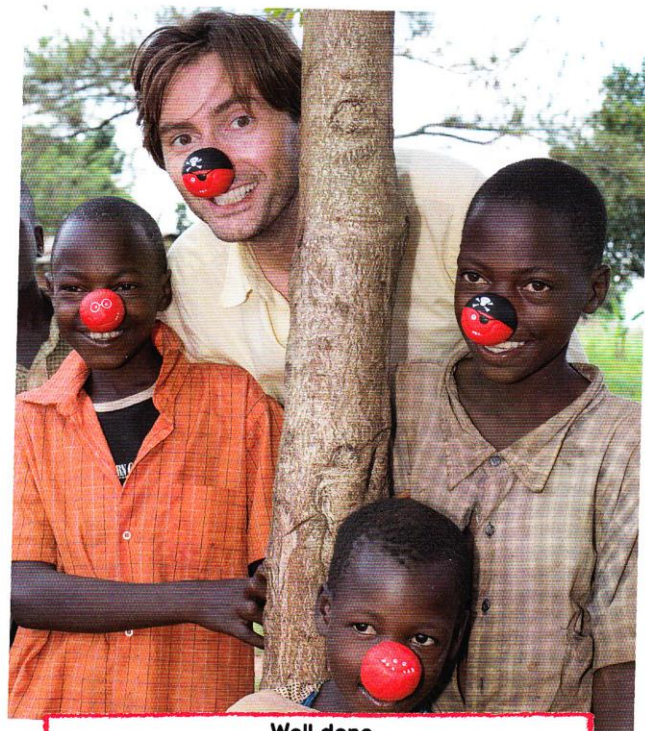
New Age Kurling – Jorge, Jack, Tommy, Tia all from 7C won Gold medals
