Year 12 Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds Workshop

On Monday 24th February Year 12 students went on a visit to the Waterhouse Restaurant in Shoreditch. Their visit was part of a short course they are doing called Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds. The workshop was run by the Shoreditch trust and arranged by Peabody trust.

The pupils got to experience what it was like to work in a professional kitchen and how to make a healthy lunch for one another. The students had to follow a recipe on their own and learnt professional knife skills to help them in their food preparation. The menu consisted of spiced chicken and vegetable kebabs, paprika sweet potato wedges, coleslaw without mayonnaise and a Tzatziki dip. Then for dessert they had pineapple and carrot muffins.

All the students thoroughly enjoyed the session and laughed about how hot the wedges were due to someone accidentally using two heaped tablespoons of chilli powder instead of paprika!
