Cricket 4 Change - Hit the Top Awards Ceremony

On Wednesday 16 April pupils from the cricket team and their parents/carers attended the 'Hit the Top' Award Evening at the Norton Rose Fulbright building in Tower Bridge. Hit the Top is a cricket programme for young people with special needs. It is the largest cricket programme of its type in the world, providing opportunities for participants to develop their self-confidence, independence and aspirations in a supportive team environment. The programme has run for over ten years and was last year shortlisted for a Sports Industry Award.

Sebastian (Year 9) was nominated for the 'Most Improved Player of the Year' Award - Sebastian has become a bit of a secret weapon amongst his team. He is given the role of batting last as he is considered a big hitter and someone who can get the big runs for the Hackney team. His batting has developed hugely in a short period of time and he is more confident when playing against other teams.

The Stormont House team - Hackney Soldiers was nominated and won the award for the 'Most Improved Team of the Year' - Hackney Soldiers have come a long way from when they started in 2012.
