## Para London Youth Games Champions

The students from Stormont House have taken part in a wide variety of sports as part of the London Youth Games, we have made up a large percentage of the squad for the Para team in Hackney. For the first time this year Hackney borough came in 3rd place in the overall competition and have succeeded in placing first in the Para Youth Games. In the LYG Athletics 2018 at Mile End Stadium, our students won 18 individual medals including 8 gold's, 6 silver and 4 bronze. As a borough the girls' team won the whole competition and the boys finished in second place out of the 32 boroughs that competed.

In the LYG Indoor Rowing competition at Crystal Palace our team finished in gold medal position as a team, Brett Yr 11 achieved a gold medal, Aesha (Year 9), Victoria (Year 11) and Angelina (Year 7) all got silver medals in their age group competitions. Well done to everyone that has taken part in this amazing sporting event.
