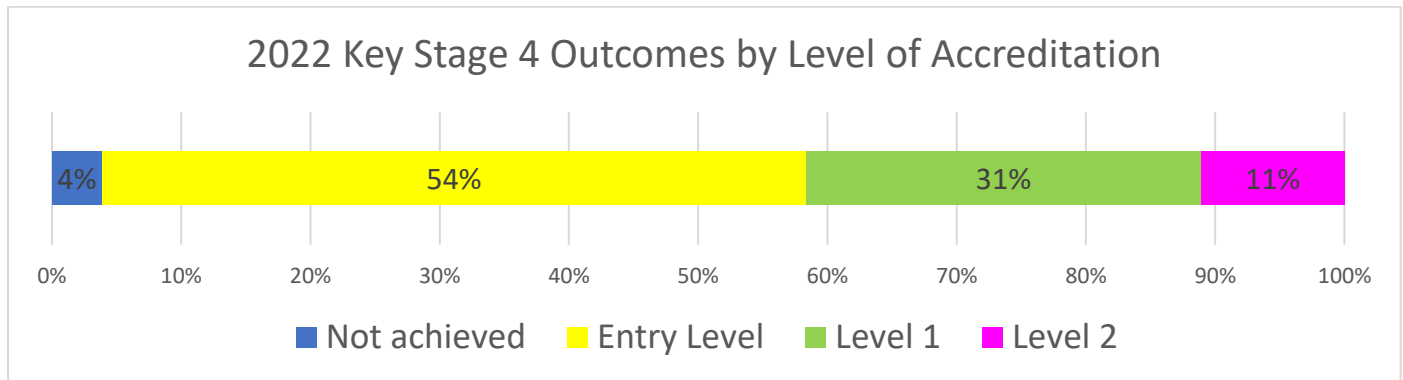


Key Stage 4 Accredited Outcomes Across All Subjects 2022

Headlines

This cohort had unusually low starting points, even in the context of our school. Even with continued high-quality provision the outcomes were anticipated to be lower than the cohort preceding (and following). As a result, there were fewer students taking GCSEs in English, maths, and science this year.

The curriculum and accreditation offer remained broad to all students. All passed short unlevelled courses in Beliefs & Values, History and Geography. Levelled accreditation courses were offered in 9 other subject areas. There was a 96% pass rate in these 9 areas ranging from Entry level to Level 2.



At the higher end, 11% of outcomes were Level 2 Awards in Food Technology and Art & Design

One student was entered for Entry Level 1 in English and maths but did not score highly enough to pass either. This was a challenging outcome to achieve in this case, and the ambition is to achieve this in Year 12. This applied to one other student in English, and also one in maths.
