## Holidays during School Term Time

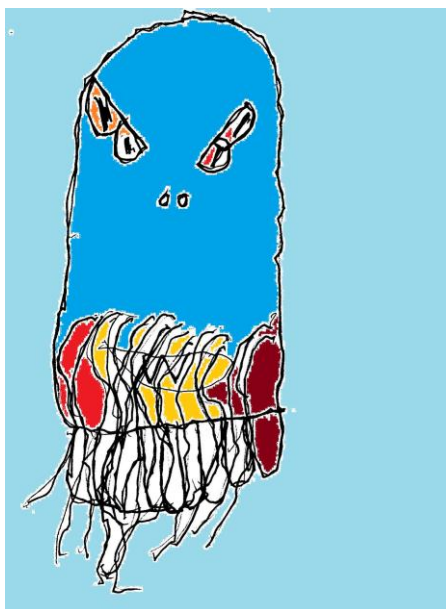

## Comic Club

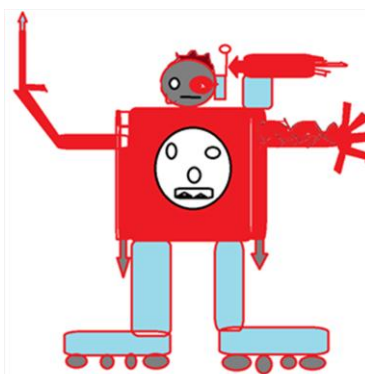
