Dear Parents and Carers,

The remaining planned days of strike action by the National Education Union (NEU) that will affect our school this term are as follows:

1. **Thursday 2 March 2023**
2. **Wednesday 15 March 2023**
3. **Thursday 16 March 2023**

As the Headteacher of the school, I have to determine the number of striking staff members on each of these days to ensure that the effective and safe provision of education continues to be achieved. I will consider each day in advance.

I'm sorry to inform you that Stormont House School will be **closed to students on Thursday 2 March 2023**. We are asking you not to send your child into school on this day. This is because I am only expecting me and one deputy to be in school, with just one of the other teaching staff. Some support staff will again need to remain at home because their children's schools are also closed.

We have not taken this decision lightly. We remain committed to providing a safe and secure learning environment for our students but would be unable to provide this with the staff we have available. We will keep Local Authority Transport teams informed.

I'm sorry that you will have to **make alternative arrangements for your child on 2 March**, and that they will experience disruption to their education. I understand that this situation may be frustrating even where there is some sympathy for the underlying reasons for the action. I appreciate that there are a wide range of views and information is presented in different ways to support those views. The NEU explain why they are taking this action [here](#).

We are working closely with our staff union representatives and Hackney Education to keep up to date with the situation, and I will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further. I will, of course, contact you to remind you of future planned strike action dates to give you as much notice as possible about arrangements for those days.
