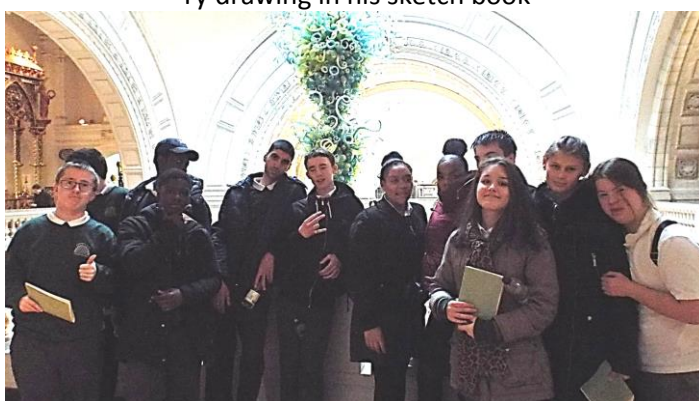
### Year 11 visit The Victoria and Albert Museum
