# Stormont House Sporting Success Boccia London Youth Games Finals – Crystal Palace

On Thursday 10 March a team of students took part in the London Youth Games Boccia finals which took place at Crystal Palace. This was the first time that a team from Hackney had qualified for the finals of the Boccia tournament. Each student performed to the best of their ability and succeeded in finishing in third place winning a bronze medal. Well done to Lorell, Connor and Joe S.

Boccia is a disability sport that tests muscle control and accuracy. Players propel balls to land close to a target ball. Two sides compete as individuals, pairs or as a team of three over a set number of ends. Each side has six balls (red or blue) each end to try and score points. Points are accumulated over the course of a match to find a winner.



### National Junior Indoor Rowing Competition – Lea Valley

On Friday 11 March, Mr Hajdrych and Mr Ramphul took Lesny, Malachi, Victoria, Shekinah, Seun, Tekia, Tyson, Zoe, Jack, Shaquille to the National Indoor Rowing Competition at Lea Valley Athletics Centre.
