St Patrick's Troupe – A Celebration for St Patrick's Day

Every year on March 17, the Irish and the Irish-at-heart across the globe observe St. Patrick's Day. What began as a religious feast day for the patron saint of Ireland has become an international festival celebrating Irish culture with parades, dancing, special foods and a whole lot of green.

On Wednesday 12 March the St Patrick's Troupe visited Stormont House to celebrate. Due to high demand the troupe spends a week visiting schools in East London to pass on the traditions of the event.

The St Patrick's Troupe is made up of pupils from across East London who either come from Ireland themselves or have parents / grandparents with Irish heritage. They performed using traditional Irish instruments (small harp, banjo, tin whistle bodhran, concertina, guitar and fiddle) and dance set dances wearing soft shoes known as ghillies and hard shoes that are similar to tap shoes.
